- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles.
- Israeli force broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Gaza and Central Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

• Detention:

- (i) At 09:30 on May 5th 2103, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Hanun –Erez Crossing detained Zuhier Ma'rouf as he was accompanying his ill wife to St. John hospital in Jerusalem despite him having a valid entry permit.
- (ii) At 10:00 on May 5th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Hanun –Erez Crossing detained Ibrahim Al-Daba'.

• Closure of Crossing Points:

- (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
- (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
