## WEST BANK

- Since 18:00 on May 4<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli military closed all crossing points of the West Bank in commemoration of the creation of The State of Israel and prevented residents including those with entry permits from Entering Jerusalem or Israel with the exception of International Diplomats, humanitarian cases and emergency health situations until 24:00 on May 6<sup>th</sup> 2014.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 22:50 on May 4<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Beit Fajjar with Dirt Mounds.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Abiyat village located in east Bethlehem until 09:15.
- (ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:40.
- (iii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou', detained residents after storming his home then withdrew at 03:40.
- (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village, detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew at 05:00.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Khadr Al-Harmi and Mohammad Al-Shiekh in Bethlehem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sabah in Taqou'.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Abdel Karim Shakarneh in Nihalin.

- **Settler Violence:**

- (i) At 12:35, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Wadi Fuqin village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
- (ii) At 15:05, Israeli settlers stormed the bypass road near Husan and Nihalin village, stoned resident and vehicles then withdrew at 16:05.

- **Demonstration:** At 18:00, a demonstration took place in Beit Fajjar protesting against Israeli closure of the village entrance with dirt mounds, during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
