JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound as a result prevented residents and workers including those with entry permits from entering Israeli and Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-

	<p>Isawiya and Al-Za'im.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Sa'id Abu Jamil, a resident of Jabal Al-Mukabbir neighbourhood in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces detained Jamal Al-Abbsi (a worker in Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in Jerusalem. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa and Ahmad Abu Al-Hawa near Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iv) On the morning of May 8th 2013, Israeli forces detained Al-Sheikh Mohammad Hussein the Grand Mufti of Al-Aqsa mosque after storming his home in Jabal Al-Mukabbir neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (v) On the morning of May 8th 2013, Israeli forces detained Mustafa Abu Zahra, (Head of the Muslim cemetery commission in the old city of Jerusalem) near the gates of Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At dawn on May 7th 2013, Israeli forces stormed Sur Al-Bahar village, stormed a home and confiscated a computer owned by Dauod Barikat. • <u>Assault on Places of Worshippers:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. (ii) On the afternoon of May 7th 2013, Israeli Police officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound assaulted and pepper sprayed several residents leaving 8 of them suffocating from pepper spray inhalation. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:00, an Israeli settler assaulted and stabbed Ibrahim Al-Shawish near "Gilo" settlement leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rummana village. (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Ya'bad

	<p>and Kafriyat village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces raided A-Taybeh and Rummana villages. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Turat Al-Sharqiya village temporarily detained Ghalib Al-Khatib, a National Security Officer. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:25, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the area of the previously abandoned settlement of “Tarela” near Sanur village. (ii) At 13:15, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the area of the previously abandoned settlement of “Dotan” near Arraba then withdrew at 17:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israel army continues to intensify its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10 and at 14:00 and again at 00:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed and searched several merchant. (ii) At 12:05 and again at 05:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusun and detained a National Security officer. (iii) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Bal’a. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Maher Khalayleh, a National Security officer in Deir Al-Ghusun. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:45, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village. (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun Atma village and temporarily detained Ahamd Amar, a resident of Siryana village and released him at a later time.

	<p>(iii) At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction.</p> <p>(iv) At 15:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqiliya.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Ras Atiya village and took photographs of several plots of land and agricultural storage rooms in the area. • <u>Detention:</u> At 02:35 on May 7th 2013, Israeli forces detained Osama Zahran as they stormed Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near Kafr Laqif village junction opened fire towards a vehicle. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ‘ale Shomron settlement. (ii) On January 17th 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing the Wall in the area. (iii) On February 6th 2013, Israeli military bulldozers levelled residential land in Jayyus for the purpose of Wall construction.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus. (ii) At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village while protecting several Israeli settlers who stormed archaeological site in the village then withdrew at 16:00. (iii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and searched a home. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Asqar camp, stormed and searched several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 05:00. (v) At dawn on May 8th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed several homes and detained 6 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:35, Israeli forces positioned at Huwwara checkpoint detained Ahmad Mabarqa, a resident of Nablus. 	<p>Hanini and Jamil Hanini in Beit Furiq.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:25, Israeli settler positioned near Huwwara checkpoint stoned vehicles and damaged a vehicle owned by Suliman Jabar and injured 5 residents with light injuries.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near Za'tara checkpoint detained Mohammad Massad, a National Security officer. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Mu'arrajat road which connects Ramallah and Jericho until 12:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho, stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 02:00. (ii) At 06:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village demolished 2 homes owned by Abdel Hay Najda and Suliman Najda for allegedly being built without proper licencing because of its location in area C.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

(ii) At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Duheisha camp in Bethlehem, stormed a home and summoned 3 residents: Alaa Muhisien, Saher Muhisien and Ahmad Muhisen to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2013, Israeli court ruled to halting the construction of the Wall near Betar village.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Wadi Qabul area near north Hebron. (ii) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Hebron. (iii) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp. (iv) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron. (v) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Halhul bridge. (vi) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 35 & 60 in north Hebron. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 children: Ahmad Suliman (16 years old) and Suliman Jihad (17 years old) near Yatta and released them at a later time. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) At 11:25, Israeli forces demolished an agricultural room owned by Qadri Hroub near Al-Qum village for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> Om May 7th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in east Yatta and damaged several olive trees owned by Mohammad Al-Jbour. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles. • Israeli force broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards North Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

(ii) At dawn on May 8th 2013, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya.
