JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beitlksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beitlksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On May 9th 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and detained a resident. (ii) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained 2 residents including a child. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Al-Shubaki during their raid into Al-Ram. (ii) Israeli forces detained Taha Abu Latif (17 years) and Salkhiya. • Home Demolition: On May 9th 2012, Israeli forces demolished a home (under construction) owned by Walid Daqiq in Beit Hanina. • Demonstrations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Palestinian peace activists marched in Anata in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'aleAdumim.

(ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras KarKar village. • Raid: At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Berih city, stormed several homes, detained a resident as well as temporarily detained Ehab Shawamra and Mashhour Al-Wihwah. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Jamal Al-Ashi during their raid into Al-Berih city. • Settler Violence: At 21:15. Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near Al-Jalazun camp road. • Demonstrations: At 13:15, Palestinian peace activist marched in front of the United Nations office in Ramallah in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces Jalmat village demolished a carwash and a vegetable cart owned by Awni Al-Umary and Zaki Zakarna for allegedly not having proper construction licences because of its location in Area C which is under Israeli military and administrative control then withdrew at 12:15. (ii) At 10:00 and again at 19:50, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, temporarily detained Mohammad Abu Baker. (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Anin village. (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Qad village. • Demonstrations: At 13:00, Palestinian activists and University students marched in Jenin in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

	<p>06:00 and 22:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40 and again at 02:30, Israeli forces raided Tayasir village. (ii) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Ibziq and prevented farmers from farming their agricultural land for alleged military practices in the area. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:00, Palestinian activists and university students marched in Tubas in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to increase their restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarm-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces raided Fuqin and setup a checkpoint at its entrance. (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Zeita. (iii) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to KafrQaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village. (ii) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village. • <u>Detention:</u> In addition to those mentioned in the previous report, At 02:00 on May 9th 2012, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Aniyat (17 years) during their raid into Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of RasAtiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in KafrLaqif village north of KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of KafrThulth town near Ma 'aleShomron settlement.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30 and again at 19:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction. (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Asira Al-Shimaliya. (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:120, Israeli forces raided Nablus. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Sharaf. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Qabalan. (iv) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Burin, stormed several homes and detained 7 residents including a Police Officer. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Bashar Eid, Qusay Qaddus, Hammam Najjar, Hamadan Eid, Alaa Qadus, Ashraf Qaddus and Ibrahim Najjar during their raid into Burin. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces demolished several barrack owned by Ahmad Kayed for allegedly not having licences because of its location in area C which is under Israeli military and administrative control. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli settlers raided agricultural land and uprooted 17 olive groves owned by Shadi Al-Zaban in Burin village. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli settlers raided agricultural land and uprooted 250 olive groves owned by Fathi Hamdan in Jamma’in village.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since April 15th 2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses and Ambulances only. The entrance had been closed since the year 2000. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Za’tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Salfit, stormed several homes then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at Za’tara checkpoint detained Jihad

	<p>Abdallah, a resident of Nablus.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of DeirIstiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Oja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30 and again at 17:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Jericho. (iii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Sultan camp in Jericho, clashed with residents as they stormed a home and detained 3 residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Awidat, Anas Abu Sharar and Munir Al-Sus.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in BeitSahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of BeitFajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting WadiFukin and Al Jab'a villages. (ii) Since 14:30 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Taqou with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Taqou. (ii) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Asaqra and stormed a home. (iii) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Harmala village, stormed a merchant store then withdrew at 12:20. (iv) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Husan village demolished a barracks owned by Firas Shusha for allegedly not having proper licencing because of its location in area C and also confiscated construction equipment owned by Eyad Jafary. (v) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and confiscated a water tank owned by Shadi Taqatqa. (vi) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Duheisha camp, stormed a home and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ghassan Abu Khiran. • Demonstration: At 09:50, family members of detainees and Palestinian activist marched in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their

Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading between Bani Na'im and Zif village to the entrance to Al-Simiyavillage access to the area. (v) Since 17:20 on April 16th 2012, Israeli military closed the entrance to Qalqis village located in southern Hebron with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fawwar junction. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Dura. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli raided Al-Urub, searched several homes and detained 4 residents including 2 children. (iii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Sair, stormed a home and detained a resident. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces detained Arif Jabir in the old city of Hebron. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Jindiya as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Sbitan (17 years), Ahmad Al-Tity (17 years) Aysar Badawi and Mohammad Adarba. (iv) Israeli forces Sufiyan Al-Hassansa. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. • Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Palestinian Attack: On the evening of May 9th 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: At 17:00 on May 6th 2012, Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Ismail (17 years) and Awadallah Rabah near the border fence.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students and passengers with permits. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, 21 truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed, fuel supplies and construction material for internationally funded projects.
