WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On May 9th 2014,The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 02:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Biddu and Al-Jib village.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullet, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hamza Jabr leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullet, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Yacoub Jamal leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 11:10.
- (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Husan village until 14:35.
- (iii) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Abiyat area in Bethlehem until 19:55.
- (iv)At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several residents and as a result suffocated Saied Al-Amour from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 00:45.

• <u>Demonstration</u>: At 13:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'assra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented protesters from reaching the demonstration site.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May $1^{\rm st}$ 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp until 16:40.
- (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
- (iii)At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction until 19:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya, stormed several homes summoned 3 residents: Abdel Karim Tanina, Yasser Tatafta and Thaer Ja'afra then withdrew at 01:30.
- (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 01:30.
- **<u>Detention</u>**: On May 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Habes Al-Alami from his home in Wadi Al-Sheikh area near the main road connecting Jerusalem and Hebron in Beit Ummar.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp temporarily detained Ahmad Al-Titi (A Palestinian Police officer) then released him at a later time.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:30, an Israeli settler stormed the home of Ghandiya Badr slammed the door shut onto the hand of the 3 year old child Ayat Badr and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and raiding Khan Yunis. Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening launching projectiles towards the Green Line.

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Detention: On the evening of May 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence from Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing into Israel.
KHAN YUNIS	 Raid: On the morning of May 9th 2014, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 200m into the vicinity of Khaz'a and opened fire as they levelled a plot of land Palestinian Attack: On the afternoon of May 9th 2014, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
