#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North West entrance of Beit Jallah.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At dawn on May 9<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Ma'asrah village and summoned Mahmoud Zawahra to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar until 15:00.
- (iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Um Salmounah village until 16:20.
- (iv)At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Taqou', detained a resident then withdrew at 01:55.
- (v) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Doha, clashed with several residents as they stormed several merchant shops and summoned Omar Abu Sarour (A resident of Al-Doha) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:30.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Sami Al-Sabah in Tagou'.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### **HEBRON**

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

## • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints in Al-Fahs area; and at Bani Na'im junction.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Hahoul Bridge until 20:35.

- (i) At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Ras Al-Aroud area located in Sa'ir.
- (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron; detained two residents including a University student then withdrew at 04:10.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Al-Jindi and Nasser Shabanah in Hebron.

#### Settler Violence:

- (i) At 20:25, an Israeli settler positioned near the market in the old city of Hebron stole a scooter from a child: Yusef Rajabi.
- (ii) At 22:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Ramat Yashi" settlement outpost located in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron stoned several residents.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

## ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and as a result injured five residents including two fishermen.
