WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. • Since 24:00 on May 5, the Israeli army imposed an entire closure on the West Bank on the occasion of the 60th anniversary for the establishment of the state of Israel, and denied civilian access into the city of Jerusalem and the Green Line, except for previously arranged humanitarian cases. The closure will continue until May 17.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Raids: At 12:30, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of Qalandia to evacuate 1 settler who entered the camp by mistake. • Arrests: At 20:00, the Israeli army arrested in the city of Jerusalem a civilian called Ahmad Khalaf Ahmad al-Badan, from the town of Tekoa in Bethlehem district. • Detention: The Israeli army detained engineer Adnan Husseini and Hatem Abdel Qader, the President's Advisors on Jerusalem Affairs, at the Israeli police station in Jerusalem and investigated them for three hours. Both advisors were asked to report to the Israeli military intelligence later. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (b) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through

	<p>the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
RAMALLAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Safa. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Ras Karkar. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the villages of Ras Karkar and Kharbatha Bani Hareth, the western entrance to the village of Ain Yabroud, and the junction of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiah with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impede civilian access. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Abu Qash. (ii) At 15:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Burqa. (iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Ein and clashed with civilians during search of 1 civilian house. (iv) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided the city of al-Bireh, searched a number of civilian houses, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 04:20. • Arrests: The civilian arrested in the city of al-Bireh is called Amjad Fayez Mohammad al-Tawil. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of al-Yamun, searched 2 civilian houses, and withdrew at 05:00. (ii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Burqin, opened fire indiscriminately during house search, and arrested 1 civilian.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The civilian arrested in the town of Burqin is called Hilal Lutfi Saleh Khalaf. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Tayasir and searched a number of civilian houses. (ii) At 17:25, the Israeli army raided the city of Toubas, searched 1 civilian house under construction, and withdrew at 18:50.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamis. (b) At 20:00, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the villages of Ramin and Bazaria with dirt barricades. (c) At 17:00, the Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun with barbed wires. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarem-Nablus road and at Jubaa checkpoint. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the towns of 'Allar and Zeita. (ii) At 10:10, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of the village of Far'on, and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 12:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the town of 'Allar. The checkpoint was set up again at 07:30. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem (ii) At 09:45, the Israeli army raided the villages of Izbet al-Tayyah and Khirbet Jbara, searched 2 civilian houses, and withdrew at 10:45. (iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Deir al-Ghusun and the village of al-Jaroushiyyeh. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural

	<p>roads east of the town of ‘Azzun</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Asla.</p> <p>(iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army closed with dirt barriers the road connecting Azzun town to Izbat Tabib village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede civilian access. At 14:10, the Israeli army closed the checkpoint because 2 veiled female civilians refused to take of the veil. The checkpoint was reopened at a later time. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the town of ‘Azzun and imposed curfew upon throwing a cocktail Molotov towards a settler vehicle on Qalqilya – Nablus road. (ii) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Qalqilya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land leveling for Wall construction continues in villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.
NABLUS	<p><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></p> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only. (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan. (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus,

	<p>searched 1 civilian house, and arrested 1 civilian.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Aseera al-Shimaliyyeh.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The civilian arrested in the city of Nablus is Mufid Sadeq Dweikat.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and Hares. In addition, the Israeli army continues to close the eastern entrance to the village of Yassouf and the southern entrance to the village of Deir Istiyya with dirt barricades, as well as the southern entrance to the town of Kafl hares and the 2 northern entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Qarawa Bani Hassan. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tara checkpoints and prevent civilian vehicles from traveling towards the town of Kafr al-Dik. At 17:00, the Israeli army closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded traffic upon the arrest of a civilian under the pretext of finding a suspicious object with him. The checkpoint was reopened at 17:40. • Raids <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Bruqin and patrolled it until 11:30. (ii) At 10:35, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafr al-Dik and patrolled it until 11:00. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. • Flying Checkpoints: At 22:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of Vered Yeriho settlement. • Attacks: At 15:30, the Israeli army opened fire towards 2 children near the bypass road east of the city of Jericho, arrested 1 while the other managed to flee. • Arrests: The civilian arrested east of the city of Jericho is called Imran

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. (ii) At 12:50, the Israeli army closed the road that connects the city of Beir Sahour and the area of 'Ush Ghurab with dirt barricades. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the east-western entrance to the city of Beit Jala. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and

	<p>the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-‘Arroub refugee camp.</p> <p>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on Wadi al-Qaf road that leads to the town of Tarqumia, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the town of Halhoul overpass. The checkpoint was set up again at 18:40 and the Israeli army searched civilian and vehicles. (iii) At 15:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Fawwar, and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron, and set up a checkpoint. (ii) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al’-Arroub, clashed with civilians, detained 1 child released him at 18:40. (iii) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Tafouh and clashed with civilians during patrol and injured a child called Sharif Youssef al-Tarwa, 16. (iv) At 18:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh. (v) At 20:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit ‘Ummar, opened fire intensively during house search, arrested 2 children under the pretext of throwing a cocktail Molotov towards a military watch tower at the entrance to the town. (vi) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura and searched 1 civilian house. • <u>Arrests:</u> The 2 civilians arrested in the town of Beit ‘Ummar are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Isaa Mohammad al-Zaaqiq, 17; and (b) Khamis Hassan Khamis, 16. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanoun (Erez) Crossing is partially open (to allow previously coordinated humanitarian access). • Palestinian Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line. (ii) At 13:00, three unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line. (iii) At 14:35, one unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line. (iv) At 21:00, four mortars were fired towards Beit Hanoun Crossing on the Green Line. (v) At 07:05, two unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.

(ii) Al-Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is partly open to let in limited amounts of fuel. • Raids: At 21:30, the Israeli army raided the area near al-Muntar – Karni Crossing east of al-Shuja'iyah neighborhood east of the city of Gaza. • Palestinian Attacks: At 15:50, three mortars were fired towards al-Shuja'iyah – Nahal Oz Crossing on the Green Line.
KHAN YOUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deaths: Yesterday evening 1 armed individual called Muntaser Mohammad Abu Anza died of injuries sustained during an Israeli raid into east of the village of Abassan al-Saghira.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: (All closed) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (al-Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (i) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) is closed. • Attacks: At dawn on May 12, the Israeli army opened fire from its posts on the Green Line towards the open area east of the area of al-Shokeh and Arafat International Airport east of the city of Rafah. • Palestinian Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, three unidentified mortars were fired towards Karm Abu Salem – Kerem Shaloma Crossing on the Green Line. (ii) At 11:00, armed individuals opened fire towards Sufa Crossing on the Green Line east of the city of Rafah.
