JERUSALEM	 Closure: On May 11th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Demonstration: At 12:00, Palestinian activists marched in Beit Iksa after Friday prayers against the closure of the town's entrance. At 12:00, palestinian activists marched in Anata in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. RAMA, PLLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoint: At 23:30, Israeli forces set up checkpoint near Atara Bridge until 01:00. Demonstration: (i) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Al Nabi Saleh against the confiscation of the village's land; Israeli forces clashed with the demonstrators leaving with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators injured and several others suffocating as a result of tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:15, two demonstrations took place in Ni'lin town and Bil'in village against the confiscation of the village's land; Israeli forces clashed with the demonstrators with Israeli forces leaving several of them suffocated from teargas inhalation. (iii) At 13:40, Palestinian activists marched in Ramallah in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. (iv) At 14:30, demonstrations took place in Aboud in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli jails; Israeli forces clashed with demonstrators injuring Majid Al-Barghouthi, leaving several others suffocated rom teargas inhalation and detained a resident. (v) At 15:40, Palestinian activists marched near the entrance of Ofar prison in Beituniya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons and clashed with Israeli forces injuring 7 demonstrators and leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. Detention: Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Barghouthi in Aboud. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Zubaba village. Raids: At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Qad village. At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Bier Al-Basha village. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoints: At 15:10, the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. Demonstrations: At 13:15, Palestinian students marched in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nahhalin village and temporarily detained 20 residents releasing them at a later time.

• Raid:

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr. Opened fire towards Abdel Aziz Jabir and Jamil Mathah as they apprehended, beat and detained them and withdrew at 15:30
- (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village stormed a home and summoned Ahmad Salah to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:00.
- (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Jala.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:30, Israeli settlers raided Al-Khadr village and uprooted 150 Grape vines owned by Ali Saleh.

• Demonstrations:

- (i) At 13:25, Palestinian activists marched in Al-Walaja against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalations.
- (ii) At 13:25, Palestinian activists marched in Al-Ma'adsra against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalations
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) At 17:20 on 16.04.2012, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Kalkas village located near the Israeli DCO south of Hebron city.
- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.

• Raids:

(i) At 10:45 and again at 23:00, Israeli force raided Hebron, occupied a home rooftop and converted it into a military post then withdrew at 23:40.

- (ii) At 12:10, Israeli force raided Halhul until 12:20.
- (iii) At 16:45, Israeli force raided Al-Thahriya until 17:00.
- (iv) At 16:45, Israeli force raided Ithna.
- (v) At 17:20, Israeli force raided Beit Awa.
- Attack: At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at Kharsa village junction fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Qawasma in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces detained Sha'ban Fanun and Shfiyan Fanun in the old city of Hebron.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 21:50, Israeli settlers assaulted Nasr Nawaj'a in Yatta leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) On the evening of May 11th 2012, Israeli settlers assaulted Walid Sabarneh as he was farming his land in Beit Ummar leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

• Demonstration:

At 13:20, a demonstration took place in Beit Ummar in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which they clashed with Israeli forces that fired teargas grenades towards demonstrators injuring Ahmad Abu Mariya and Khaldoun Masharqa as well as leaving several demonstrators suffocated as a result of Tear gas inhalation.

• <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.

Palestinian Attack: On the afternoon of May 11th 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line. 		
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
