<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 12:05, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint thus impeding the free flow of traffic and again closed it at 07:00 thus impeding the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 08:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on May 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained two residents. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, injured Ahmad Al-Saawi and detained a resident. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabala, stormed two merchant shops and detained a resident. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident. (v) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Sawahra Al-Sharqiya village. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Musa Darwish and Issam Darwish in Al-Eisawiya village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Zahran in Qalandiya camp. (iii) Israeli forces detained Abeed Al-Fuqiya in Bir Nabalah. (iv) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Ja’afra (A resident of Al-Sawahra Al-Sharqiya village) in Al-Eizariya. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: On the afternoon of May 11th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Silwad and detained a resident. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child Ra’fat Abu Libdeh (16 years old) then withdrew at 10:15. (ii) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several school children then withdrew at 10:45. (iii) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Abboud, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:40. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:25 on May 11th 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Khaled Al-Ramahi (17 years old) and Sharhabil Nakhlah during their raid into Al-Jalazoun camp as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the west entrance of Silwad detained Haytham Ayad. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ali Al-Majid and Abdallah Al-Jarn in Abboud. • Attack: At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and closed the main entrance gate leading to the village and then reopened it as they withdrew at 13:00.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zabuba village until 09:45. (ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint At Al-Shuhada village junction until 09:20. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya’bad until 18:15. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Fanduqumiya village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 12:55. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village, inspected surveillance camera footage for several merchant shops then took photographs of several homes and withdrew at 13:30. (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces raided Ras Atiyah village, levelled a plot of land located in the east area then withdrew at 13:45. • Detention: At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Qalqiliya detained Ahmad Hassan (A resident of Qalqiliya) after chasing his vehicle. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 14:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 12:25. • Raid: At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Madma village. • Home Occupation: At 20:05, Israeli forces stormed Huwarah and occupied Ahmad Al-Haj's home then converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew later.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 01:40.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 24:00. (ii) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-New'meh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 17:00. (iii) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained two National Security Force officers: Ahmad Al-Wazir and Jaber Awad as they were returning from a military training course then released them later. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at at Al-Hamra checkpoint (set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District) temporarily detained three Presidential Guards: Qassim Yassin, Mohammad Jamalan and Salah Na'irat then released them at 18:05.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walajaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Husan village, summoned two residents: Diya Za'oul and Mohammad Za'oul to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:10. • <u>Detention:</u> On May 10th 2015, Israeli forces detained Omar Mohammad (A resident of Bethlehem) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Surif village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar detained

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement as they raided and opened fire towards Gaza. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza

(ii) At 21:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in West Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Raid: At 07:30 on May 11th 2015, Israeli forces escorting Military bulldozers stormed 150 m into the vicinity of east Al-Shuja'iyah neighbourhood located in east Gaza and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land then withdrew at 13:00.

Attack: On the evening of May 11th 2015, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land located in east Al-Buriej camp.

(ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.
