JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 12:05, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint thus impeded the free flow of traffic and again closed it at 07:00 thus impeding the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 08:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Jaba’ village. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Hizma village. (iii) At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khan Al-Hamra area , temporarily seized a bus carrying armed National Security Force officers and aimed their weapons towards the bus, during which an Israeli soldier prepared to open fire towards Hussien Salim (A National Security Force officer) after a heated discussion with him then Israeli forces allowed the bus to pass through after penalizing the bus driver: Nitham Al-Dik (A Security Force officer), confiscated his drivers licence and summoned him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Annan and clashed with its residents. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Qutna village and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained three residents including a child: Yusef Hazinah (14 years old), Ibrahim Al-Natsha and Mamdouh Al-Ajlouni in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint detained Abdel-Rahman Hamdan (A university student). (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village

	<p>detained Yusef Darwish.</p> <p>(iv) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Khaled Taha and Al-Fuqiya in Qutna village</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Eyoun Al-Haramiya area junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus until 12:30. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Ibzi' village and clashed with several residents. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Sufa village, stormed the village park then withdrew at 12:30. (iii) At 12:30, Israeli forces Al-Bireh city until 13:00. (iv) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Bir Ziet and detained a resident after storming his home. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Kamal Abd Rabbo after storming his home in Bir Ziet.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village until 01:30. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Bir Al-Basha village then stormed and searched a home. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confiscation of Property: At 21:05, Israeli forces positioned near Khirbeit Humsa area located in the North Jordan valley confiscated an agricultural tractor owned by Salem Ka'abneh.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 09:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Zibad village until 02:00. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aboush village until 23:20.

<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of immatin village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Ras Atiya village until 11:10. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Sir Village until 01:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Subustiya village until 01:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Subustiya village as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed archaeological sites in the village then withdrew at 10:45. (ii) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents until 01:20. (iii) At dawn on May 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Awrata village then stormed and searched several homes. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near a Military checkpoint in Jabal Al-Tur area located in south Nablus temporarily detained 4 residents: Jihad Aqat (a resident of Nablus) and 3 unidentified residents for allegedly carrying a knife and released them after assaulting them • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Jallud village and levelled plots of land near "Ihiya" settlement in order to expand it.

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint under Skaka's Bridge searching cars, and civilians. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Iskaka village, stormed seven homes then withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Rafaat village, stormed two homes then withdrew at 03:10. • Temporary Detention: At 09:25, Israeli forces positioned near Barkan settlement temporarily detained Mohammad Ishtayeh (A Palestine Television Journalist) then released him at 09:45.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:25 and again at 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho and detained two residents. • Raid: At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Marj Al-Na'jeh village, stormed three homes and confiscated two identifications cards owned by Ahmad Masoud and his wife. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Yusrah Tafish (A resident of Qalqiliya) upon her return from Jordan (ii) Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho detained Mohammad Mahmoud Sbitan and Mohammad Sbitan.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carnisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 22:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Taqou’ until 12:20. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Jab’a village then stormed and searched a home. (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, temporarily detained Tawfiq Salah (Head of the local village council) then released him at 21:10. (iv) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah and Al-Doha. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On May 12th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Khilat Iskirah village and served a military order for the demolition of a livestock den owned by Mohammad Assad and served a military order for halt of construction for three home for allegedly being built without licences.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and Road #35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

(iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Yatta. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Imad Al-Turat (A resident of Sa'ir) for allegedly carrying a knife. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child: Salah Abu Sneineh (10 years old) then released him at 18:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On May 12th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Sweisiya village and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Khalil Nawaj'a. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On May 12th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Zif village and uprooted and chopped down 300 trees in a natural reserve Forrest owned by Omarn Abu Sbieh which were planted with help from the Palestinian Ministry of Agriculture and several other International Non-Profit Organisations. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of May 11th 2015, an armed Israeli settler stormed Al-Ja'bari neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and damaged several trees planted around Ahmad Al-Ja'bari's home and attempted to assault him. (ii) At 18:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron stoned Yasser Markhiya's home and as a result injured his daughter Jana leaving her hospitalised with contusions.
