#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 12:05, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint thus impeded the free flow of traffic and again closed it at 07:00 thus impeding the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 08:00.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

#### Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 00:25 on May 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Geuvara Hantouli during their raid into Al-Doha as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ziyad Issa and Tariq Al-Jahalin in Al-Khader.
- <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint temporarily seized two National Security Force vehicle then allowed them to pass through at 16:55.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and Road #35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 13:35.
- (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Tarusat village and detained a resident after storming a home.

# HEBRON

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 04:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron detained Mohammad Abu Hammad after storming his home.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Fatah Akimi in Tarusat village.

#### • Temporary Detention:

- (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Nathmi Jaradat then released him at 16:10.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child: Farhan Al-Rajabi (10 years old) then released him at 18:40.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:55, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron stormed residents and homes.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza, Gaza, Central and Khan Yunis.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

# NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 21:20 on May 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Waha area located in North West Beit Lahiya.
- (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Abu Samira area located in North West Beit Lahiya.
- (iii) At 10:40, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Abu Safiya area in east Jabaliya.
- (iv) At 00:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area in west Beit Lahiya.

#### Closure of Crossing Points:

- (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
- (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
