(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through

	<p>Qalandiya checkpoint.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents and shut down several merchant shops. • <u>Detention:</u> On May 14th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Barakat, a resident of Al-Nabi Samuel. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces demolished an Aluminium factory owned by Mohammad Jabber and a Barracks owned by Eweis Family in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem for allegedly being built without licence. (ii) On May 14th 2014, Israeli forces demolished a storage room owned by Musa Al-Natsheh in Al-Shaqra neighbourhood for allegedly being built without a licence. (iii) On May 14th 2014, Israeli forces demolished a merchant shop owned by Mohammad Odeh in Shu’fat neighbourhood for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 24:00 on May 13th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and sprayed 2 residents: Raja’I Al-Huda and Jihad Al-Muhtasib with pepper spray. • <u>Demolition:</u> On May 14th 2014, a demonstration took place near the International Red Cross headquarters in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.

(iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the bypass road located between Surda and Ein Qiniya until 10:30. • <u>Raid:</u>

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jenin until 15:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Bardala village, served demolition orders to demolish 6 barracks owned by: Yusef Rashaydeh, Izit Rashaydeh, Mohammad Rashatedeh, Amar Sawafta, Hussien Sawafta and Khaled Sawafta for allegedly being built without licences. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces served halt to construction orders for a road connecting Atuf and Al-Ras Al-Hunra village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 10:30 • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 06:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 10:00. (ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Jayyus and Azzun until 12:40.

	<p>(iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 14:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed and searched a home and a merchant shop, detained a resident, stormed a home and detained a child (total detained are 2 residents including a child). (ii) At 13:00 and again at 23:0, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth, summoned Omar Issa to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at “Aial” checkpoint near the Green Line detained 4 residents: Rashid Ishtaya, May Abu Salaymeh, , Badr Ishtaya and Mohammad Nimr. (ii) At 17:45, Israeli forces positioned at “Aial” checkpoint near the Green Line detained Qasem Abed, a resident of Salfit as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence based on a prior summon. (iii) Israeli forces detained Munthir Salameh (16 years old) and Murjan Jabarin in Azzun. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Azzun seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed it to pass through at 17:35. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:15. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village until 11:35. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint, temporarily detained 2 residents Hamza Haboub (17 years old) and Ghassan Mabrouk then released them at a later time. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:25. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Fadi Al-Jabri and Osama Al-Fara near Z'tara checkpoint. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hani Qassul in Kafr Al-Dik. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nu'emeh village. (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 22:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifirat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

(iii) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area east Beit Sahur until 20:45. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 08:45, Israeli forces installed several settler trailers on land owned by Al-Sabah family in Taqou’ • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
