<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Since 07:00 on ,ay 14<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city for the Shovout Holiday and set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city thus preventing resident from entering Jerusalem with the exception of those with Permits and Emergency Humanitarian cases.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic.

- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- **Raid:** At 16:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and detained a resident.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Duquq village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured Eyad Raslan.
- (v) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Isawiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sa'diya neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Demonstrations:**

- (i) At 10:00, demonstrations took place in commemoration of 65<sup>th</sup> of "Al-Nakba" (The Catastrophe imposed by Israeli Occupation and forcible removal of Palestinians from their home land) at Bab Al-Amoud gate the entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque in the old city of Jerusalem and called for the implementation of United Nations Resolutions for the Right of Return for Palestinian refugees during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result caused several of them suffocation from tear gas inhalation and detained 2 residents including a child.
- (ii) At 11:00, demonstrations took place in commemoration of 65<sup>th</sup> of "Al-Nakba" (The Catastrophe imposed by Israeli Occupation and forcible removal of Palestinians from their home land) in Al-Za'im village and called for the implementation of United Nations Resolutions for the Right of Return for Palestinian refugees.
- (iii) At 17:00, demonstrations took place in commemoration of 65<sup>th</sup> of "Al-Nakba" (The Catastrophe imposed by Israeli Occupation and forcible removal of Palestinians from their home land) in Abu Dis and called for the implementation of United Nations Resolutions for the Right of Return for Palestinian refugees.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mus'ad Shahin in Al-Ram.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Omar Muna (16 years old) and Alaa Jamjoum in Jerusalem.

- **Assault on Places of Worship:**

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked several worshippers during which worshippers clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to prevent the settler assault.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old

<p><b>TUBAS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 13:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al – Far'a and Al-Bithan villages, detained 2 residents including a University student then withdrew at 14:25.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Tubas, clashed with its residents as they stormed a home, critically injured 2 residents: Omar Abdul Raziq and Isar Masalmi confiscated a computer and damaged Sa'ed Fuqaha's vehicle then withdrew at 02:35.</li> </ul>
