### **WEST BANK**

### • Closure:

- On May 15<sup>th</sup> 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound (In Commemoration with the 66 anniversary of Al-Nakba (Catastrophe).
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and students in Al-Quds University Campus and as a result set fire to several trees on the University campus then withdrew at 20:40.

### **Detention:**

### **JERUSALEM**

- (i) At 04:00 on May 15<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained 3 children: Mahdi Abu Sneineh (15 years old), Ahamd Al-Agha (15 years old) and Abdallah Al-Joulani (15 years old).
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem detained Musabih Abu Sbieh as he was taking part in a demonstration (In Commemoration with the 66 anniversary of Al-Nakba (Catastrophe).
- (iii) At dawn on May 16<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained Jamal Hawas after storming his home and confiscating a computer.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained 3 residents including a child : Abed Barar (12 years old), Yasser Qawes and Foad Al-Khatib as they were demonstrating (In Commemoration with the 66 anniversary of Al-Nakba (Catastrophe) then released them at a later time.

### Attack:

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning 0:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in
- (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
- (iv) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 03:20 on May 14<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained 6 residents including a child: Ahmad Atta (17 years old). Ahmad Abdel Khier Atta, Ahmad Al-Barghouthi, Amar Atta, Mohammad Hussein Atta and Billal Al-Barghouthi.

### Attack

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards

### • Raid:

- (i) At 18:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem.
- (ii)At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents and as a result injured a child: Omar Dar Salah (4 years old) then withdrew at 00:30.
- (iii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 09:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Walaja village in Commemoration with the 66 anniversary of Al-Nakba (Catastrophe) and calling for the Implementation of United Nations Resolutions calling for the right of Return, during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired tear gas grenades and as a result set fire to several trees and the Palestinian Civil defence forces were able to extinguish the flames.

### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to

- "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.

### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at along Halhul bridge until 08:45.
- (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Einun village junction.
- (iii)At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp.
- (iv)At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Huwar area junction located at the north entrance of Halhul and detained a resident.

### • Raid:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and stormed and searched 4 homes.
- (ii) At 09:35, Israeli forces raided Yatta until 10:30.
- (iii)At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron, clashed with several residents and as a result injured 6 residents including 5 children: Hamza Abu Hammad (13 years old), Ayman Idris (13 years old), Diya Abdel Hafith (16 years old), Yazan Al-Sha'wouri (17 years old), Ali Ghayth (17 years old) and Oday Al-Tarad then withdrew at 20:00.
- (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna until 02:30.

### • Attack:

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at Khursa village junction, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 12:25 and again 22:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning

At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- <u>Detention</u>: Israeli force positioned at Al-Huwar junction located at the north entrance of Halhul detained Khaled Zama'reh.
- <u>Temporary Detention</u>: At 09:10, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained 3 children: Qusay Al-Ja'bari (13 years old), Qasem Al-Ja'bari (11 years old) and Salah Al-Ja'bari (13 years old) then released them at a later time.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

# At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
