	Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.
	Closure:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.  (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.  • Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil
HEBRON	villages.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) At 17:20 on 16.04.2012, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Kalkas village located near the Israeli DCO south of Hebron city.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.

### • Raids:

- (i) At 15:20, Israeli force raided Ithna.
- (ii) At 02:35, Israeli force raided Halhul, stormed several homes, summoned Waleed Sha'ban, Abdel Muhsin Zamar'a and Ahmad Zama'a.
- (iii) At 12:55, Israeli force raided Tafuh and summoned Tarik Ra'fat and Hamza Al-Tura to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- Attack: At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned at Bani Na'im fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas towards several residents for alleged stoning leaving Baha Zidan and Nidal Manasra hospitalised with contusions.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces detained Khalid Jabrin in the old city of Hebron.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:30, several worshipers marched after Friday prayers in Tel Alrumayda in the old city of Hebron against settlements and closures of the area (closed since 1994)
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00.</li> <li>On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.</li> <li>Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by firing from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza.</li> <li>Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
