(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint

	<p>near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Jib village and demolished a merchant shop owned by Hassan Abu Diya and a Carpentry shop owned by Tallal Al-Asmar for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers stormed Samir Amis area in north Jerusalem and levelled a plot of land owned by Matwali Family and fired rubber coated steel bullet s, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they attempted to prevent the levelling and as a result injured Mohammad Ishtayeh, detained a resident then withdrew at 17:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained 7 residents: Haytham Abu Mariz, Billal Salim, Yacoub Al-Taweel, Ayman Izat, Riyad Awadallah, Ahmad Al-Ramlawi and Raed Al-Zagheir in Jerusalem. (ii) On May 20th 2014, Israeli forces detained Issa Attalah, a resident of Al-Eizariya for allegedly entering Jerusalem without a valid permit. (iii) Israeli forces detained Abed Al-Sirisi in Samir Amis area located in North Jerusalem. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem assaulted and injured Samer Al-Araj after taking him to an Israeli Police station then released him at 06:30. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 17:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli Prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nazlah Al-Sharqiya village until 01:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Far’un village, stormed several homes then withdrew at 12:40. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction until 12:50. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:10. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan until 13:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained 2 residents: including a child Hamza Riziq (17 years old) and Jallal Mina for allegedly finding a knife in their possession. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained Yunis Ayash, a resident of Rafaat village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.

(ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 11:50. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr. (iv) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 21:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents until 11:00. (ii) At 08:55, Israeli forces raided Husan village until 09:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Azraq (15 years old) a resident of Al-Duheisha camp in Bethlehem as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2013, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Qabbun area junction located in North Hebron until 09:30.
 - (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Rishah area in Ithna until 17:00.
 - (iii) At 17:54 and again at 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Ithna junction until 22:25.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on May 20th 2014, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident.
 - (ii) At dawn on May 20th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes, detained a resident and summoned Ahmad Al-Salibi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
 - (iii) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Yatta, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and merchant shops and as a result injured Tamer Abu Sbeiha after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister in the face.
 - (iv) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village until 12:30.
 - (v) At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Khursa village, occupied the rooftop of Yusef Al-Shahatits home and converted into a military post and damaged the main entrance door of Mohammad A-Manouras home then withdrew at 01:00.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 02:00 on May 20th 2014, Israeli forces detained Yusef Al-Azza in Al-Fawwar camp.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Bara' Qawasmeh in Hebron.
 - (iii) Israeli forces detained Safwat Khalil in Beit Ummar.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
