JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.</li> <li><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li><b>Raids:</b> The Israeli army raided the town of Bir Nibala and searched a number of civilian houses.</li> <li><b>Wall Gates:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</li> </ul>

In addition, the Israeli army handed notifications to demolish house walls under the pretext of unlicensed construction and the removal of a water tank used for irrigating plants.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(ii) At 08:20, the Israeli army raided the area between the towns of Bruqin and Kafr al-Dik, and combed it until 10:20.</li> <li>(iii) At 10:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafr al-Dik and patrolled it until 11:50.</li> <li>(iv) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Salfit and patrolled it until 12:00.</li> <li>(v) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Masha, searched 2 commercial stores, and then withdrew at 16:40.</li> <li>(vi) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Dier Istiyya and patrolled it until 22:30.</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> At 08:30, the Israeli army detained at Za'tara checkpoint a civilian called Firas Daoud Abdel Azim Ibdah, from the village of Marda, and released him at 12:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:10, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the D.C.O. checkpoint that is set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and impeded traffic.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> At 15:10, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of Vered Yeriho settlement, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> At 02:40, the Israel army raided the village of al-Nouweimeh, arrested 1 civilian, and detained a military officer but released him at 05:15.</li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army arrested at al-Karama (Allenby) Crossing a civilian called Ibrahim Abdel Rahman Froukh, from the town of Sa'ir in Hebron district, while he was on his way back from Jordan.</li> <li>(ii) The civilian arrested in the village of al-Nouweimeh is called Mohammad Shehadeh Muslem Drei'at.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BETHLEHEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> At 15:10, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Nashash southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem), and searched civilian and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>HEBRON</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. - (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
    - (i) At 08:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the town of Halhoul overpass. The checkpoint was set up again at 19:00 and the Israeli army searched civilians and vehicles.
    - (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the entrance to the area of al-Nabi Younis.
  - **Raids:**
    - (i) At dawn on May 21, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Samet and searched 1 civilian house..
    - (ii) At 11:15, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp of al-Arroub, stormed a boys’ school, and arrested 5 pupils under the pretext of throwing stones towards the watch tower set up on the entrance to the refugee camp.
    - (iii) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta, searched 1 civilian house and a services office and confiscated 1 computer from it, and arrested 1 civilian.
    - (iv) At 13:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, The raid recurred at 21:30 and at 01:00 during which the Israeli army searched 1 civilian house.
    - (v) At 17:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Tarqumia.

### PRISONERS CONDITIONS

- The Israeli military court at Salem detention camp sentenced prisoner Bashir Tawfiq Fayez Sabaghneh to 33 months in jail, and prisoner Hussein Abdel Latif to 22 months in jail and a fine of 2000 shekels, equivalent to 560 dollars, and prisoner Mohammad Zeidan Mohammad al-Jada' to 18 months in jail and a fine of 2000 shekels, equivalent to 560 dollars. In addition, the court extended the administrative detention of 4 prisoners from Jenin and Tulkarem districts.
