- (v) Since 17:20 on 16.04.2012, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Kalkas village located near the Israeli DCO south of Hebron city.

- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On the morning of May 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, Israeli forces levelled approximately 13 dunums of land in Hebron owned by Rashid Jabr, Rashad Jabr, Shadi Jabr, Nimer Jabr, Mohammad Jabr, Wahi Jabr, Fadi Jabr and Jabr Jabr.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:00, Israeli settlers assaulted Nasr Nawaj'a while he was farming his land with several International peace activists leaving him injured with contusions.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
