- <u>Attacks:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al Arrub refugee camp, fired tear gas towards people allegedly for throwing a Molotov cocktail.

- (i) The detained in Beit Aowa is: Raed Masalma.
- (ii) The 4 detained in Beit Ummar town are: Mohammed Maraia, Alaa Zahkek, Mohammed Sabarna and Hussam Abu Maraia.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces positioned at the green line broke the seize fire by attacking Palestinian towns and village in Gaza Strip, in particularly in Rafah city and by attacking fishermen boats near North and Central Gaza.
