	(i) On May 2nd 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
	<u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

	 years old) and Mohammad Ayad. (ii) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Ahmad Husiien (17 years old).
	(iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber

	coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents

	construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and
	as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
	(ii) At 13:10, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting
	against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction
	during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired live ammunition,
	stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left
	several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

	• <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli error continues to close the Dait Isle Wedi Ahmed reads a read

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
	 (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
	 Flving Checkpoint: (i) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Betar village until 12:00. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou' until 20:30. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Husan village, temporarily detained two residents: Osama Shousheh and Khalil Shousheh then released them at 23:50. Raid: At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Um Rakaba area located in Al-Khader, clashed with several residents and occupied Jaml Shahins home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 19:00. Settler Violence: At 15:35, Israeli settlers positioned along the main road between Husan and Nihalin villages stoned residents and vehicles. Demonstration: At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and prevented them from reaching the demonstration site.
	 <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
HEBRON	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour
roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to
Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit
Annun with cement blocks.
(v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat
and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Khan Yunis.
NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination and issued permits 200 residents to enter Jerusalem for those residents above the age of 60 to pray in Al-Aqsa mosque. <u>Attack:</u> At 12:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	 (i) <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
