	guard at Al-Aqsa mosque compound) to house arrest until May 26 th 2015.
	(iii) On May 24 th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Absat gate (a Main
	gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of

	 Jerusalem temporarily detained Mohammad Qazaz (A journalist) then released him after serving him military order preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 7 days. <u>Attack:</u> At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Wad road in the old city of Jerusalem, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and assaulted Aboud Ramlawi leaving him hospitalised with head injuries. <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. <u>Wall Gates:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic
