WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint, which is on the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic heading towards Ramallah.
- **Raid:** At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Samir Amis area located in North Jerusalem, temporarily detained 2 residents: Jihad Al-Ghazawi and F’oad Al-Ghazawi then released them later.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At dawn on May 25th 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents including two children: Rateb Al-Himouni (17 years old), Mohammad Abu Nab (17 years old) and Fihmi Al-Hamouni in Silwan neighbourhood as mentioned in the previous report.
 - (ii) At dawn on May 25th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Aliyan during their raid into Al-Eisaiya village as mentioned in the previous report.
 - (iii) At 09:00, Israeli force positioned near Bab Hata gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) detained Layth Ghayth, Ahmad Al-Shawish, Ahmad Badriya and Shadi Abu Farha.
 - (iv) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Salaslal gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) detained three residents: Mohammad Al-Hashlamoun, Nathim Abu Ramouz and Taha Shawahneh.
 - (v) At 23:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Saed Assaliya and Jamal Abu Nab in the old city of Jerusalem.
- **Attack:** At 06:00 on May 25th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Salim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and as a result set fire to a vehicle during which Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the flames.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 10:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Raid: At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:20. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Qadi in Al-Bireh city.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Burqin and Kafr Qud villages. (ii) At 12:50, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Jab'a, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and caves. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, inspected several water wells then withdrew at 10:30. (ii) At 16:35, Israeli forces raided Attil, stormed and searched four homes then withdrew at 04:40. (iii) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Allar until 18:50. (iv) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Far'oun village until 04:50. (v) At 05:45, Israeli forces raided Shoukiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Fermata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum until 20:00. • Raid: At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village until 01:50.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Fada Obied at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Ahmad Bahar (A resident of Nablus) along the main road in Al-Nabi Eliyas village and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 04:45, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 06:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Nablus, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ya’ish in Nablus. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned near “Barkhat” settlement temporarily detained the child Oday Mansour (14 years old) {a resident of Kafr Qalil village then released him later. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of May 25th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Mas’audiya area located near Burqa village and attacked a local park owned by Palestinian Worker Union.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 13:55.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 13:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Taqou' and detained a Security Force Officer. • Raid: At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 13:30. • Detention: Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near the entrance of Taqou' detained Mohammad Al-Qaddari (National Security Force Officer) {A resident of Bir Al-Basha village in Jenin}. • Attack: At 09:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
