# WEST BANK

# **Closure:** At dawn on May 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, the Israeli army intensified their restrictions at (i) the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads: JERUSALEM** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to

construct the wall.

• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu until 18:00.

# • Raid:

- (i) At dawn on May 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Qubiya village and detained a resident as they stormed his home.
- (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Biddu, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 11:20.
- (iii) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Annan village until 11:50.
- **Physical Assault:** At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem assaulted Sabrin Obied leaving her injured with contusions.

# • Obstruction of Places of Worship:

- (i) At dawn on May 28<sup>th</sup> 2014. Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces clashed with several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack.

#### • Detention:

- (i) On May 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Abdel Fattah Al-Fakhouri and Sa'eb Al-Fakhouri as they stormed their home near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem and assaulted Zeinab Al-Fakhouri (72 years old) leaving her hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem detained the child Husam Ghniem (15 years old).
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents including a child: Moath Khalil and Amar Qunbar in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iv) At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate detained Ghayth Nassar.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Nidal Makhtoub in Al-Qubiya village.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Jamil Abbassi and Nur Abu Wahdan in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 19:40, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem assaulted several residents, journalists and attacked several merchant shops during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and as a result injured 4 residents and 3 Turkish tourists.
- **<u>Demonstration:</u>** At 14:00, a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem protesting against settler violence and calling for the establishment of a Palestinian state and the end of the Israeli Occupation during which Israeli forces assaulted demonstrators and confiscated Palestinian flags they were waving.

# • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of

	Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
	Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.  (ii) Since September 3 <sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

# • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

# • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 16:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Madma village junction, prevented resident's from entering or exiting the village until 18:00.
- (ii) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction until 18:00.
- (iii) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Halhul until 18:30.
- (iv) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Asira Al-Qibliya and Madama village junctions until 20:40.
- (v) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Bithan road located at the east entrance of Nablus until 23:20.

- (iii)Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Hamza Dariya, Jallal Dariya and Sameh Dariya in Beit Fajjar.
- <u>Fire Attach</u>: At 09: 05, Israeli forces shot tier gaz during confrontation near the area of El madares in the city of E Khader in the district of Bethlehem, temporary detained the child Yusuf Raja Issa 14 years old, and released him at 10:30.

# • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May  $1^{st}$  2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

# • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

#### HEBRON

- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 19<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 13:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp, clashed with several children then withdrew at 15:00.

#### Raid:

- (i) At 11:40 and again at 18:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed Anatil's grave and Harmm Al-Ramallah well.
- (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Asal Al-Tahta village, searched a home then withdrew at 14:00.
- (iii) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp until 01:00.

(iv) At 05: 50, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 06:15.

# • Detention:

- (i) At 02:35 on May 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Ashraf Jabarin, Tamer Jabarin, Mohammad Jabarin and Oday Jabarin.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Abu Awad (16 years old) at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
- <u>Injury:</u> At 14:30, the child Anan Abu Ayash was critically injured after he crashing a vehicle he was driving while being apprehended by Israeli military vehicle leaving him hospitalised with contusions and during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several residents leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 10:45. Israeli settlers stormed Al-Rajabi building in the old city of Hebron and conducted Talmudic rituals.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 11:00, demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian Detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
