# • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

## • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction.
- (ii) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area located in north Hebron.
- (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Halhul bridge.
- (iv)At 13:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 10:10 and again at 17:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a vehicle shop and a restaurant then withdrew at 18:35.
- (ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuyukh.
- (iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Ithna until 17:10.
- (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta and Al-Samou'.
- (v) At 05:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched several homes and a bakery and then detained 2 residents.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Al-Burj village detained Ismail Al-Houroub a resident of Deir Sammit
- (ii)Israeli forces detained Shadi Baher and Muntassir Awad in Hebron.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards Tariq Bin Zayid School in the old city of Hebron for alleged stoning.

# HEBRON

- Assault on Property: On October 30<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces stormed Ithna and served halt to construction orders for 2 homes owned by Hamdan Bashir and Mohammad Hamdan for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location on area C.
  - <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

# At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. **ALL DISTRICTS** Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding Khan Yunis. Israeli Military aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles towards Khan Yunis and as a result killed 4 Palestinian gunmen. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores of Gaza. Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 3 projectiles towards the Green Line.
