| JERUSALEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 31st 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikka village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> On October 30th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Salaslak gate, which leads to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and assaulted Jad Al-Ghoul (A Guard in Al-Aqsa mosque) as he attempted to enter the mosque and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village, in Al-thur, Ras Al-Amoud, Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhoods, near Shu’fat and Qalandiya checkpoints, near Al-Ram and Anata and near Al-Salaslak gate in the old city of Jerusalem , fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents including 2 children: Bara’ Issa (17 years old) {Critically injured}, Khalid Al-Masi (14 years old), Ziena Jadallah, Diya’ Shihadeh, Muntasir Hamad and Osama Aliyan. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Anata, at Shu’fat, Al-Suwana, Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: |

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 11:30, on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Bet El Settlement located near Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents, left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a Palestine Television Journalist. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near “Bet El” settlement located in North Al-Bireh city base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of “Ofar” Military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ali Dar Ali (a Television journalist) in Silwad. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as result injured 2 residents including a child and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and |

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:15, Israeli forces closed Barta'a checkpoint for alleged stoning and fireworks incident towards the checkpoint then reopened it at 19:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned at "Movo Dotan" checkpoint located in south Ya'bad temporarily detained Ibrahim Amarneh then released him at 24:00. |
| TULKAREM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shufa village temporarily detained three residents: Khalid Yassin, Mohammad Yassin and Yahya Yassin (All residents of Tulkarem) then released them later. |

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. |

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Salfit until 24:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Yasuf village until 23:30. |

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern |

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction (located at the south entrance of Bethlehem) until 14:35.
 - (ii) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou until 17:15.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 14:45.
 - (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Wadi Quffin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:00.
 - (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Taqou, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured Ahmad Al-Bithan and occupied Riyadh Al-Amours home and converted its roof top into a military post then withdrew at 16:20.
 - (iv) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, stormed a home and detained a resident.
 - (v) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwarat village, stormed two homes, summoned Mu’tasim Abu Ramis to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:15.
 - (vi) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village, summoned two residents: Walid Al-Shiekh and Musa Al-Shiekh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:05.
 - (vii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 04:15.
 - **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohamad Al-Aza in Al-Ayda camp.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Hamarat.
 - **Demonstration:** At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma’sara village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades while preventing protesters from reaching the demonstration

| HEBRON | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou' until 11:20. • Attack: At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned near Halhul bridge fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Temporary Detention: At 12:20, Israeli force positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Adnan Masaudeh for allegedly carrying a screw driver then released him at 15:15. |
