ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bared in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bared to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bared, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. • Flying Checkpoints: At 13:00, the Israeli army set up 4 flying checkpoints at the entrances to the towns of Bir Nabala, Beit Hanina, and Al 'Eizariya, as well the village of Beit 'Anan and searched civilians and vehicles. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Fayzah Fodah, a female civilian, after having summoned her to Al Muscobiya (the Russian compound) Interrogation and Detention Centre in the city of Jerusalem.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids/Curfew/Destruction/Confiscation of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:05, the Israeli army raided the village of Kharbatha al Misbah. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army while it was patrolling the area. (ii) At 00:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Abu Shukheidim and arrested 1 civilian. (iii) At 01:50, the Israeli army raided Al Jalazun refugee camp, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. (iv) At 04:50, the Israeli army, including 15 jeeps, raided a neighbourhood in the city of El Bireh, imposed curfew, and searched 1 building, after having used explosives to destroy its doors. The Israeli army also arrested 2 civilians and well as 1 Palestinian National Security officer and confiscated 2 pistols from them. On the outskirts of Al Am'ari refugee camp, an armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. At 06:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested Mash'hour Mohammed Salameh in the town of Abu Shukheidim. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Ahmed Jamal Abu Nakhleh in Al Jalazun refugee camp. <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians and 1 Palestinian security officer in the city of El Bireh:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Khaled Nathmi Samarah, a Palestinian National Security officer; (iv) Nasser al 'Anani; and (v) Mohammed as Sa'idi. • <u>Air Patrol:</u> At 02:50, Israeli combat helicopters patrolled the skies over the city of El Bireh.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> In addition to operating surveillance cameras, the Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 09:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one on the settler bypass road east of the city of Jenin and the other in the area between the villages of Sanur and Al Jarba, and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids/Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Yamun, opened indiscriminate fire, and searched 1 house. At 04:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Far'a, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 university student. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 12:00, Israeli troops positioned at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas arrested 2 children: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser Mohammed Abu Mihsen, 16 years old; and (ii) Kamal Jamal Abu Mihsen, 17 years old. (iii) The Israeli army arrested Mahmoud Suheil Daraghmeh in the village of Al Far'a.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Raids/Attack/Injuries/House Occupation/Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, the Israeli army, including 15 jeeps, raided the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army while it was searching a number of houses in the city and the refugee camp. During the confrontations, the Israeli army injured 4 children. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in Tulkarem refugee camp, occupied 1 house, and converted it into a military post. At 10:50, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 02:20, the Israeli army, including 13 jeeps, raided the city of Tulkarem and searched 1 building, after detaining residents. The Israeli army also detained 1 Palestinian National Security officer and withdrew at 03:00. (iii) At 02:25, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Anabta and arrested 1 civilian.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in Tulkarem refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mohammed Mahmoud Barakeh; and (ii) Yousef Khalil Abu Tahoun. (iii) The Israeli army arrested Muhannad ‘Imad Kan’an in the town of ‘Anabta.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years unless accompanied by one of their parents. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun. • Raid/Attack: At 02:10, the Israeli army, including 11 jeeps, raided the city of Qalqiliya, fired sound grenades, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. At 05:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Mahmoud Sufyan Nazzal in the city of Qalqiliya.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus, as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. (ii) Al Badhan checkpoint (set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) remains closed with dirt barricades. (iii) Nablus-‘Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00. (iv) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (v) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the city of Nablus and the village of Till, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids/Attack/Destruction of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided Balata and ‘Askar refugee camps, opened fire, fired sound grenades, searched a number of houses, and arrested 3 civilians. In Balata refugee camp, the Israeli army damaged a number of civilian vehicles. At 05:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, searched 3 houses, and arrested 1 civilian. At 05:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up on the road to the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya arrested Ali Hasan Fares. <p>The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in Balata and ‘Askar refugee camps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Mahmoud Ali Khalil; (iii) Maher Jum’ah al Badawi; and (iv) Ala’ Mustafa Abu Salem. (v) The Israeli army arrested Nafez Mohammed Nasser in the city of Nablus. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:15, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Alon Moreh threw stones at civilian residents of the village of Deir al Hatab, while they were harvesting olive crops on their land near the settlement.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint and to deny access to civilians under 35 years. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari’el.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al ‘Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 17:10, and again at 20:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of ‘Ein ad Duyuk and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu‘man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the “Container”) checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of ‘Ayda refugee camp, and northwest of the city of Beit Jala. • <u>Raids/Air Patrol/Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Beit Jala and patrolled the area. (ii) At 09:50, Israeli troops, dispatched by a combat helicopter, raided an area near the village of Dar Salah, set up a checkpoint at the village’s entrance, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 13:20, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (iii) At 10:00, and again at 21:45, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 4 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem. (iv) At 23:25, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of ‘Eilet Ali and arrested 2 civilians. The Israeli army also detained 3 civilians and released them at 01:30. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of ‘Eilet Ali: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Ayman Khalil Ali; and (ii) ‘Issam ‘Ata ash Sha’er.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada’ Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba’ to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta. • <u>Raids/House Occupation:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint in the area of Ras al Jora, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhul. (iii) At 19:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Nuba. (iv) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta, occupied 1 house, and converted it into a military post. (v) At 23:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beginning on 25 June 2006, the Israeli army has reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the northern and eastern borders of the district of Northern Gaza. Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases. • <u>Incursion/Air Patrol/Attacks/Injuries/Injuries/House Occupations:</u> Beginning at 01:20 on 01 November 2006, the Israeli army, covered by combat helicopters and reconnaissance aircraft, has continued to reinforce its presence in the town of Beit Hanun, the area of Abu Safiya, and Beit Hanun (Erez) Industrial Zone. Israeli armoured vehicles and combat helicopters opened intensive fire and tanks fired shells towards the entrance to the town of Beit Hanun as well as towards civilian houses and the area of Quleibu. In addition, armed confrontations continued to take place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals, during which the Israeli army killed 6 civilians, including 1 elderly female civilian. Of those killed, a civilian died of a heart attack while Israeli troops were raiding his house. The Israeli army also injured 29 civilians, including 10 children and 2

female civilians. Of those injured, 5 civilians were in critical condition. Additionally, the Israeli army occupied a number of houses and converted them into military posts. Having detained and interrogated civilians, the Israeli army searched several other houses. Moreover, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians, including 2 brothers, demolished 3 houses completely, damaged 10 other houses, and levelled a vast area of agricultural land. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.

- **Killings:** The Israeli army killed 6 civilians in the town of Beit Hanun:
 - (i) Ziyad Ahmed al Basyouni, 70 years old;
 - (ii) Ahmed Suheil 'Udwan;
 - (iii) Yousef Rawhi 'Aqel;
 - (iv) Khalil Nasser Hamad;
 - (v) 'Issam Mahmoud Abu 'Odeh; and
 - (vi) Mahmoud Khalil Fayyadh, who died of a heart attack.
- **Arrests:** The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Beit Hanun:
 - (i) Hikmat Sameer Hamad;
 - (ii) Mohammed Sameer Hamad; and
 - (iii) Saed al Kafarneh.
- **House Demolitions:** The Israeli army demolished 3 houses in the town of Beit Hanun. Names of these houses' owners are unknown.
- **Air Attacks/Injuries/Destruction of Property:**
 - (i) At 17:00, Israeli F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards a street in the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (ii) At 17:50, an Israeli combat helicopter fired 1 missile towards and damaged a commercial shop in the town of Beit Hanun. The air attack also resulted in the injury of 5 civilians.
 - (iii) At 19:00, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards the area of Qa'et al Bir in the town of Beit Hanun, injuring 2 civilians, including Rami Dabbour who was in critical condition.
- **Attacks/Injury:**
 - (i) At 16:55, the Israeli army fired 1 missile mortar from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near Al Qarya al Badawiya north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
 - (ii) At 20:35, the Israeli army opened fire from its position on Palestinian territory towards a gathering of civilians at the entrance to the town of Beit Hanun, injuring 1 child.
 - (iii) Between 21:40 and 21:55, the Israeli army fired 3 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Tallet ar Rayyes east of the town of Jabalya.
- **Palestinian Attacks:**
 - (i) At 13:25, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
 - (ii) At 13:30, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
 - (iii) At 14:10, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
 - (iv) At 14:25, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
 - (v) At 14:35, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
 - (vi) At 14:40, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
 - (vii) At 16:30, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
