WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later.
- <u>Injury:</u> At 12:30 on October 31st 2014, Atita Shabaneh was injured after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister to the head during confrontations with Israeli forces in Jerusalem as mentioned in the previous report.

• Detention:

- (i) At 09:00 on October 31st 2014, Israeli forces detained Yacoub Halabi (A resident of Abu Dis) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
- (ii) At 09:00 on October 31st 2014, Israeli forces detained Zienat Abu Sbieh (A school girl) near Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- Attack: At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. Flying Checkpoint: At 17:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge. At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al. At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud.
JENIN	Closure of Main Road: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.
TUBAS	 Assault on Property: Israeli forces served eviction notices for 14 families in Ibziq village and Ras Al-Hamra area in tubas to leave their homes from 12:00 on November 2nd, 3rd and 4th 2014 until 18:00 in order to conduct military training.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. Checkpoint: At 19:15, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic until 20:00.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jit village until 11:00. At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the maon road connecting Jayyus and Azzun until 17:00. At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the

	Closure: Since December 17 th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

	Closure of Main Roads:						
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road						

between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Raid:

- (i) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed several homes, summoned 3 residents: Hamdi Hassan, Orabi Jawarish and Ahmad Hirmani to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:25.
- (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar; summoned Ali Taqatqa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:40.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained Atta Abu Hamidan (A resident of Balata camp in Nablus).
- <u>Attack:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Demonstration:** At 12:30, a demonstration took place near Al-Jab'a village protesting against the continued closure of a road, which connects Surif, and Jab'a village during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result, Mohammad Al-Tus suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate.
- (vii)At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
- Raid:
 - (i) At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Ein Faris area located in Dura.
 - (ii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 04:30.
 - (iii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Dura until 03:20.
 - (iv) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya.
- Attack: At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

GAZA STRIP

• At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
