WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) On November 1st 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.
- (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.
- (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.
- (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.
- (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.

Raid:

(i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained a resident.

JERUSALEM

- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Qutana village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child Hassan Mohammad Taha (17 years old) and as a result left him hospitalised.
- (iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis.

• Detention:

- (i) On October 29th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jib detained Alaa Bidies (A resident of Al-Jadera village).
- (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Abdel-Azziz Hamad Mahmoud Mir'I (A resident of Abu Dis).
- (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint detained Ibrahim Abdallah Abu Nassar (a resident of Qalandiya camp).
- (iv) At 21:30, Israeli forces detained Shadi Al-Abdallah (A resident of Al-Sunah neighbourhood in Jerusalem).
- (v) At 22:00, Israeli forces detained Khaled Khashan near Shu'fat checkpoint.
- (vi) At 04:00, Israeli forces detained Laiyth Al-Husseini after assaulting him as they stormed his home in Shu'fat camp.
- (vii)Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Abdallah Darbas in Al-Eisawiya village.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood temporarily detained two children: Omar Abu Khadeir (8 years old) and Yusef Abu Khadeir (7 years old) for alleged stoning then released them at 19:30.

• Attack:

- (i) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mazen Ahmad Abu Al-Hummus.
- (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun grenades in side "Abu Ghanam" Coffee shop after assaulting several residents as they stormed it.

• Assault on Places of Worship:

- (i) At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces escorting workers from the Israel Antiquities Authority stormed Al-Marwani mosque in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> On November 1st 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Al-Nabi Samuel village and destroyed a barbed wire fence surrounding a plot of land owned by Ayed Barakat.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

Attack: At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned in "Ghishouri" factory area located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) and as a result, left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate Raid: (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Fanduq village then stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Azzun and clashed with several residents. Settler Violence: (i) At 12:00, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land located in North East Far'ata village and assaulted several residents who were collecting Olive harvest and as a result injured Murad Abdel-Min'em Shn'a with contusions. (ii) At 18:25, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Ala Hussni Ibrahim Al-Khatib (A resident of Jayyus) near the entrance of Azzun and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	 Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin;
NABLUS	and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. At 22:00 on October 3 rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds.

	 Flying Checkpoint: At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction located along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles. Raid: (i) At 04:00 on November 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Qusra village and detained two residents. (ii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents as they stormed a building and detained 5 residents and confiscated 23000 NIS from the home of Ahmad Othman Ja'rat then withdrew at 05:50.
	Detention: (i) Israeli forces detained two residents: Hussien Mohammad Ahamd Abu Rudaya and Tariq Abu Rudaya in Qusra village. (ii) Israeli forces detained five residents: Mohammad Billal Abdel-Rahim Al-Azzizi, Izu Rafiq Abu Kalibat, Ahmad Nabil Al-Qani, Ahmad Othman Ja'rat and Mohammad Sa'di Fatoum in Nablus.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Kafil Harris and Harris village then searched residents and vehicles. At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Kafil Harris and Deir Istiya then searched residents and vehicles. At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harris, impeded the free flow of traffic from both directions after closing the steel gate entrance the reopened it at a later time. At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Deir Istiya then searched residents and vehicles. Raid: At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya and stormed two homes including the home of the head of the town council. Settler Violence: At 20:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near the military watch tower near at the entrance of Kafil Harris and hurled a firebomb towards the home of Khaled Abd Shaqur.
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allanby Bridge temporarily detained Ramah Mowafaq Mahmoud Ali Nassir as he was returning from Jordan then released him later.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Jinata then searched residents and vehicles until 10:15.
- (ii) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Taqou' then searched residents and vehicles until 10:25.
- (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marah Rabah village then searched residents and vehicles until 17:05.
- (iv) At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched residents and vehicles until 17:45.

• Raid:

- (i) At 07:30 on November 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed a home of Ramadan Thawabteh (the 8-month-old infant killed by Israeli forces) then withdrew at 08:30.
- (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several school children during which they fired rubber coated steel bullets towards a Solid

BETHLEHEM

- waste truck owned by Al-Khader Municipality and as a result, injured Mussid Salah then withdrew at 15:10.
- (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Husan village until 20:25.
- (iv) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Jurat Al-Shama'a village and detained a resident.
- (v) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp until 02:40.
- (vi) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident and summoned three residents: Salah Abd Rabbo Thawabteh, Alaa Khaled Issa Samour and Na'el Na'im Omar Thawabteh then withdrew at 03:30.
- (vii)At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:35.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ahamd Hussien Araf in Jurat Al-Shama'a village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Mohammad Ibrahim Al-Qawasmeh in Beit Fajjar.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Nathmi Ahmad Fawaz in Bethlehem.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Iz Al-Din Mohammad Zaghoul (11 years old) {a resident of Husan village} as he was near his home located at the entrance of Husan village then released him at 21:40.

• Attack:

- (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents.
- (ii) At 15:55 Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.

Flying Checkpoint:

(i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.

HEBRON

- (ii) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron {located along bypass road (35) near Halhul Bridge} then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iv) At 07:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Yunis junction located along the main road connecting Hebron and prevented resident under the age of 30 from passing through.

• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on November 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Rabboud village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, closed the main entrance {after 3 Israeli soldiers were injured after being hit by a vehicle passing near Beit Announ junction during which the driver: Ahmad Yaqqin Yusef Al-Ja'bari turned himself over to the Israeli military}during which they clashed with several residents and as a result injured 3 residents: Jafar Khalil Abdel-Rahim Al-Matour, Ahmad Nayef Jibril and Abdel-Hadi Saket Matour during which Israeli forces stormed a health clinic and confiscated surveillance camera footage from the clinic then temporarily detained Omar Abidien (A journalist) and released him at a later time then withdrew at 19:10.
- (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Sha'abin area located in east Yatta.
- (iv) At 22:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ma'moun Abdel-Aziz Haribat in Raboud village.

• Attack:

- (i) At 07:45 on November 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Abu Al-Rish checkpoint in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Anoun village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they were participating in the funeral of Raed Jaradat (A resident of Sa'ir) during which they opened fire towards a resident and as a result killed him for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier (As alleged by the Israeli Military) and then proceeded to prevent an Ambulance from reaching the area as well as leaving several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (iii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in west Beit Awwa fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 19:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Fadi Hassan Abbas Al-Faroukh (27 years old) {A resident of Sa'ir} near Beit Anoun village junction.
- <u>Injury:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces injured Yahya Issam Raba' (a resident of Hajja village in Qalqiliya) after opening fire towards him near the wall gate in Hebron as he attempted to cross into Israel looking for work.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 11:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron prevented several school children from leaving their school to go home.
- (ii) At 14:15, an Israeli settler driving a vehicle in Beit Ummar opened fire towards a home owned by Izat Khalil Sabarnah during which Israeli forces stormed and searched the house.

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by **ALL DISTRICTS** the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical **NORTHERN** patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad **GAZA** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Al-Buriej camp as they were CENTRAL protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and **GAZA** as a result injured 2 residents and left another suffocated from tear gas inhalation. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed **RAFAH** (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction

material funded by UNRWA.
