ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. Raid: At 00:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Biddu.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni’lin, Bil’in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of ‘Abud and the village of Beit Sira. • <u>Raids:</u> At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah and Al Am’ari refugee camp, searched a number of houses, and arrested 3 civilians as well as 1 Palestinian Police officer. Among the arrested civilians was the Palestinian Minister of Public Works. At 03:40, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians and 1 Palestinian security officer in the city of Ramallah and Al Am’ari refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Abdul Rahman Zeidan, the Palestinian Minister of Public Works; (ii) Ayman as Sabbar, a Palestinian Police officer; (iii) Hamadeh Husni Badrah; and (iv) Waleed Ali ‘Aabed. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Talmon stole 120 kilograms of olives as well as tools used in harvesting olive crops. In addition, Israeli settlers cut down 4 olive trees belonging to Jamal Haleil in the village of Al Janiya.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> In addition to operating surveillance cameras, the Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Tubas, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 2 civilians (a high school (<i>Tawjihi</i>) student and a university student). (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up 5 flying checkpoints on the junctions to the towns of ‘Arraba, Qabatiya, Tubas, and Kafr Malik as well as the village of Misliya. Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of ‘Anin and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 21:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Tubas and the village of ‘Aqqaba and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> At 07:30, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Jenin.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Tubas arrested 2 civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Omar 'Izz ad Din Abu Mihsen, 17 years old; and (ii) Tayseer 'Izzat Abu Hasan.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Raids/Attacks/Detentions: At 09:10, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem. At 14:45, the Israeli army raided the city again and opened indiscriminate fire while searching a house. The Israeli army also arrested 1 civilian and detained 3 others, including 2 university students. At 05:00, the Israeli army raided the city for the third time, opened intensive fire, and searched 1 house after detaining residents. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 1 civilian as well as 1 Palestinian National Security officer, thereby increasing the number of those arrested to 3. At 05:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians and 1 Palestinian security officer in the city of Tulkarem: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Nayef Mohammed Abu Zant, a Palestinian National Security officer; (ii) Mohammed Dhmeiri; and (iii) Ahmed 'Izzat Zandeeq.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years unless accompanied by one of their parents. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. • Raid: At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Azzun.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus, as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. (ii) Al Badhan checkpoint (set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) remains closed with dirt barricades. (iii) Nablus-‘Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00. (iv) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (v) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. • Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Yitzhar and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids/Attacks/Injuries/Physical Assault/Destruction of Property: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Sabastiya. (ii) At 21:25, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided Balata refugee camp in the city of Nablus and opened intensive fire, injuring 1 Palestinian Police officer. The Israeli army arrested 1 civilian and severely beat another, after which he was transported to Nablus Public Hospital for medical treatment. At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the refugee camp again and opened intensive fire, killing 1 child and injuring 2 civilians. Of those injured, Ahmed Mohammed Sanakreh (described by the Israeli army as a “wanted individual” and a brother of the killed civilian) was in critical condition. In addition, the Israeli army destroyed a civilian vehicle (using explosives) and withdrew at 05:00. • Killing: The Israeli army killed 16-year-old Ibrahim Mohammed Sanakreh in Balata refugee camp. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Rasheed Abu Kishek in Balata refugee camp.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the village of Yasuf and searched civilians and vehicles until 19:15. • Raid: At 18:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Deir Istiya and patrolled the area until 18:30.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs. • Flying Checkpoint/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 17:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint opposite a Palestinian National Security checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:30. • Raid: At 00:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Fasayil and took position at its entrance, after stones had been thrown at Israeli settlers travelling along Road # 90.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits. • Wall Construction: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of 'Ayda refugee camp, and northwest of the city of Beit Jala. (ii) At 10:50, the Israeli army began land levelling for Wall construction in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. • Raids/Attacks/Destruction of Property/Injuries: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the cities of Bethlehem and Beit Jala as well as 'Ayda refugee camp. (ii) At 18:35, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of Bethlehem and patrolled the area until 20:00. (iii) At 03:10, the Israeli army, including 19 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided the city of Bethlehem and Ad Duheisha refugee camp. While searching

	<p>a house, the Israeli army opened fire, damaging furniture. The Israeli army also arrested 1 civilian. An armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals, during which the Israeli army injured 3 civilians, including 1 child. Of these, Fatima Abdul Fattah Zahran, a female civilian, sustained critical bullet wounds. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Husam Ibrahim Hassan in the city of Bethlehem.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahim Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta. • Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the dawn of 02 November 2006, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, searched a number of houses, and arrested 8 civilians. (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of Hebron, raided the yard of <i>Al Muqata'a</i> (the complex of Palestinian security agencies), took photographs of the complex, and patrolled the area. At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 8 civilians in the city of Hebron: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Rafeeq Badr ash Shweiki;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Hani Khamis ash Shweiki; (iii) Ala' Abdul Muhsen as Sayyed; (iv) Mohammed Bahr an Natsheh; (v) Tareq Nayef Gheith; (vi) Riyadh Sublaban; (vii) Yousef Mahmoud an Natsheh; and (viii) Dhiya' Abu Sneineh. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence/Injury:</u> At 18:00, an Israeli settler bus travelling along the Halhul-Hebron road ran over Hameedeh Mohammed Khalil, a 70-year-old female civilian, leaving her with critical injuries.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beginning on 25 June 2006, the Israeli army has reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the northern and eastern borders of the district of Northern Gaza. Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases. • <u>Incursion/Air Patrol/Attacks/Curfew/Attack on Religious Site/Injuries:</u> Beginning at 01:20 on 01 November 2006, the Israeli army, covered by combat helicopters and reconnaissance aircraft, has continued to reinforce its presence in the town of Beit Hanun, the area of Abu Safiya, and Beit Hanun (Erez) Industrial Zone. Israeli armoured vehicles and combat helicopters opened intensive fire and tanks fired shells. The Israeli army also imposed curfew and demanded that civilians between 16 and 45 years of age gather in the College of Agriculture in the town of Beit Hanun. In addition, armed confrontations continued to take place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. Claiming that armed Palestinian individuals were hiding inside, the Israeli army surrounded as well as demolished 1 mosque. Furthermore, the Israeli army opened fire towards female protestors, who marched in order to uplift the siege on the mosque. Additionally, the Israeli army opened intensive fire and fired tank shells towards civilian houses in the town of Beit Hanun, killing 8 civilians, including 2 children and 3 female civilians, and injuring 18 others, including 4 female civilians and 1 journalist. The Israeli army also damaged a number of houses, levelled the road around the town, occupied several houses, and converted them into military posts. Having detained and interrogated residents, the Israeli army searched many other houses. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning. • <u>Air Attacks/Injuries:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, an Israeli combat helicopter fired 1 missile towards Palestinian territory near a gas station at the entrance to the town of Beit Hanun. (ii) At 17:30, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards 1 civilian vehicle east of Jabalya refugee camp, but the missile missed the vehicle.

	<p>(iii) At 21:10, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards a group of armed Palestinian individuals on the intersection of As Sikka Street east of the town of Jabalya, killing 2 armed Palestinian individuals and injuring another.</p> <p>(iv) At 22:10, an Israeli UAV fired 2 missiles towards a gathering of civilians in the area Sha'sha'a east of Jabalya refugee camp, killing 2 civilians and critically injuring Iyad Ali Jadallah.</p> <p>(v) At 00:55, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards a group of armed Palestinian individuals in the area of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu, killing 1 civilian and injuring 2 armed Palestinian individuals.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Killings: The Israeli army killed 8 civilians in the town of Beit Hanun: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Bara'ah Fayyadh, 4 years old; (ii) Ahmed Suhweil, 15 years old; (iii) Raja' Jabr Abu 'Odeh, a female civilian; (iv) Intissar Abdul Majeed Abdul Malek, a female civilian; (v) In'am Salem, a female civilian; (vi) 'Azeezeh Ghaben, a female civilian; (vii) Basel Mohammed al Jammal; (viii) Mohammed Sameer Mahmoud; and (ix) Hamzeh Mohammed Karshouh. <p>The Israeli air force killed 2 armed Palestinian individuals east of the town of Jabalya:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (x) Hasan Saleh Salah; and (xi) Shadi as Shareef. <p>The Israeli air force killed 2 civilians in the area of Sha'sha'a east of Jabalya refugee camp:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (xii) Sami Abdullah Abu Sal'ah; and (xiii) Suhayb Rafeeq 'Udwan. (xiv) The Israeli air force killed Mohammed Kamel Abu Khater in the area of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attacks: Between 08:00 on 02 November 2006 and 08:00 on 03 November 2006, the Israeli army fired 125 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near the area of Al Hawuz, the American School, and the horsemanship club as well as in the areas of As Sudaniya and Abu Hassira north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. • Raid: At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 10 armoured vehicles, raided Palestinian territory and took position in the area northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. • Palestinian Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line. (ii) At 14:25, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line. (iii) At 19:10, 3 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
