Home Demolition	*4	-	4	Israeli forces demolished a home in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighborhood in Jerusalem, demolished 3 Apartments in Beit Hanina in Jerusalem. *Israeli forces served a military order for the demolition of 2 homes {1 in Beit Awa and the other in Hebron}.
Assault on Education Sector	1	-	1	Israeli forces stormed Al-Quds University Campus in Abu Dis in Jerusalem.
Confiscation of Property	4	-	4	Israeli forces confiscated 3 surveillance camera footage tapes from merchant shops in Ramallah and radio broadcast equipment from a radio station {Voice of Freedom} in Hebron.
Assault on Property	2	-	2	*Israeli forces served military orders for the eviction of 12 families from their home in Humsa Al-Foqa village located in the North Jordan Valley area in Tubas District from 06:30 until 24:00 for alleged military training in the area.
Destruction of Property	4	-	4	Israeli forces broke open the main gate entrance of the Admissions department in Al-Quds University Campus in Abu Dis in Jerusalem, damaged home furniture after storming and searching 2 homes in Salfit and Israeli settler damaged a vehicle windshield after stoning vehicles near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement in Bethlehem.
Closure (per District)	8	-	8	Including 2 in Jerusalem, 2 in Nablus, 2 in Bethlehem and 4 in Hebron.

Closure of Main Roads	-	5	5	Including 6 in Jerusalem, 3 in Ramallah, 3 in Jenin, 3 in Tulkarem, 3 in Qalqiliya, 5 in Nablus, 6 in Salfit, 23 in Bethlehem and 20 in Hebron.
Closure of Crossings	69	-	69	Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
Assault on Places of Worship	1	-	1	Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
Settler Violence	5	-	5	Israeli settlers stormed Homish settlement area {previously abandoned} in Jenin, Assaulted a resident in Qalqiliya, set fire to Olive trees in Burin village and prevented residents from collecting Olive harvest in Beit Furiq in Nablus district and stoned vehicles near "Kafir Itsiyon" settlement in Bethlehem.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma village then searched residents and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b></li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and Al-Sawaher Al-Sharqiya village.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:30 and again at 03:40, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several University students and as a result injured 25 residents and left 31 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation during which Israeli forces stormed Al-Quds University Campus in Abu Dis and broke open the main gate entrance of the Admissions department.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Haddaf (A merchant) after assaulting him in Jerusalem.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained Hanadi Mohammad Al-Halwani as he was in Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood temporarily detained the child: Reem Mohammad Jamil Qanbar (13 years old) for allegedly planning to knife attack then released her after imposing a financial penalty amounting to 3000 NIS and put her under home detention until November 8<sup>th</sup> 2015.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qutna village fired live ammunition fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning {as they were participating in the funeral of 2 residents killed Israeli forces} and as a result injured 8 residents and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Hizma village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Home Demolition:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:00, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem and demolished the home (80 m<sup>2</sup>) owned by Sami Idris.</li> <li>(ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces stormed Beit Hanina and demolished three apartment owned by Khaldoun Nijim, Mohammad Al-Dasouqi and Mahdi Al-Dasouqi.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:00 on November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Silwad with Cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah Bridge located in North Bir Ziet then searched residents and vehicles. <b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 14:30, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:15.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Bal’a, stormed and searched Ziyad Rida Mohammad Mir’is home {who Israeli forces accuse of attempting to stab an Israeli settler in Nataniya town inside the Green Line} and the stormed and searched the home of Ali Sa’id Yaccoub then withdrew at 06:30.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> On November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Ziyad Rida Mohammad Mir’I (22 years old) {A resident of Bal’a} after he was critically injured after Israeli forces opened fire towards him for attempting to stab an Israeli settler in Nataniya town inside the Green Line {as alleged by the Israeli military}.</li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem temporarily detained the child Azzam Marwan Bader (13 years old) {a resident of Tulkarem} then released him at 19:30 after assaulting him.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate (623) located in Deir Al-Ghussoun temporarily detained Assad Aliyan Assad Salah (A resident of Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem) then released him at 19:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned in “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) and as a result, left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILIYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds</li> <li>(iv) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Fanduq village then searched residents and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in the east area of Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 19:25, Israeli settlers positioned near Azzoun Atma village assaulted Asma Raja Muslim Abdallah (A resident of Qabalan in Nablus) and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>NABLUS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:00 on October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 13:00, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic because a group of Israeli settler were positioned near the checkpoint then reopened it later.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed Joseph’s Tomb, clashed with several residents and as a result, set fire to a supermarket then detained two residents and withdrew at 05:30.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Yacoub Abdel-Latif Ishtayeh and Ahmad Khalil Shalabi in Nablus.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 18:45, Israeli forces positioned near Osirin village junction opened fire towards several residents.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:15, a group of Israeli settlers from “Yitsahar” settlement stormed agricultural land in Burin village and set fire to a plot of agricultural land planted with Olive trees during which they proceeded to assault several residents who were collecting Olive harvests then withdrew at 15:25.</li> <li>(ii) At 00:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the entrance of Beit Furiq and prevented residents from entering the area then withdrew at 00:55.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 08:00 and again at 12:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic then proceeded to close the checkpoint after opening fire towards a vehicle then reopened it at 14:10.</li> </ul>

## HEBRON

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
