JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On the morning of October 13th 2011, Israeli forces closed Shofat checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, and fired teargas grenades towards demonstrators who marched in solidarity with Palestinian detainees, who have been on a hunger strike for the past 17 days. The checkpoint was later reopened. • <u>Detention:</u> At dawn on November 4th 2011, Israeli forces detained Yaqoub Abu Asab in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Ein Arik village.

<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided an area between Awarta and Ajoul village. (iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Beitunia, stormed several houses, detained 2 residents and withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detentions:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Faro'a as he was hearing his sheep near "Pesagot" settlement in El-Bireh City. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Al-Yamoun village, searching people and cars. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Qad junction, searching people and cars. • <u>Detention:</u> In addition to those mentioned in the previous report, Israeli forces detained Yousef Assaf during their raid into Qabatiya, At 02:00, on November 3rd 2011. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:55 the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and at 12:45 impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces setup a flying checkpoint at Ras village junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Beit Lid junction, searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and set up a flying checkpoint until 12:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
<p>QALQILYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying checkpoints:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again at 18:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzoun, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 15:45 and again at 19:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Tulkarem, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Laqif, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village, searching civilians and vehicles. (v) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Hija village, searching civilians and vehicles. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 (ii) At ‘Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (iii) At 12:20, Israeli forced increased restrictions at Huwara checkpoint, impeding the free flow of traffic until 16:00. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Fourik junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 13:00 and again at 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Yizhar settlement junction north of Huwara, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance Madma village, searching civilians and vehicles. (v) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Qassri village, searching

	<p>civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30 on November 2nd 2011, Israeli forces raided Asira Al Qibliya 1 village, stormed a home and took photographs of the home. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Askar refugee camp in Nablus and searched 2 homes.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:25 the Israeli army increased restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15 and again at 01:00, Israeli forces raided Burqin until 02:15 (ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Daher Sabah area in Kafr Al-Dik and surveyed the area. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harres village until 02:15 • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned at Zaatara checkpoint detained Amjad Fadil. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 01:15 armed settlers raided Kafil Harres, stoned a home and withdrew at 01:45. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqbat Al-Jabir refugee camp, stormed several homes, detained a civilian and withdrew at 02:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ismail Al Jamil during their raid into Aqbat Al-Jaber refugee camp in Jericho
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al

	<p>Jab'a villages.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Harmalat village, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: At 10:25, Israeli special forces raided Bethlehem and detained a resident • Detention: Israeli forces detained Khaled Salem during their raid into Bethlehem. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. • Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar town. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoints: At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint after closing the main entrance into Beit Ummar and detained a resident • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Surif. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ula, during which confrontations ensued between residents and Israeli troops (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Yatta, searched a home and detained a resident. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained the children Amjad Salhab and Iz Al-Din Salhab in Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces detained Jaffar Awad during their raid into Beit Ummar. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ala'a Al Shamti during their raid into Yatta • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. Israeli fighter jets broke the ceasefire agreement by firing missiles towards North Gaza resulting in the death of 2 residents.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Raid: On the afternoon of November 3rd 2011, Israeli forces, supported by military aircrafts, raided North Gaza and Israeli fighter jets fired 2 missiles towards a group of armed Palestinians, killing two. Attack: On the evening of November 3rd 2011 Israeli forces fired 3 artillery shells towards Beit Lahia. Killing: Israeli jets launched missiles killing Mohammad Abu Hilmiya and Nasser Elayan
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. Al Awda crossing – Rafah is open for patients, students and civilians with permits.
