JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to

(ii) At dawn on November 4th 2013, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Obayda Sa'id (15 years old) and Othman Said (13 years old) after storming their home in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Issa Jafal in Abu Dis. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On November 3rd 2013, Israeli Authorities approved tenders for the construction 1889 settlement units including (828 housing units in the settlements built in Jerusalem and the 1061 settlement housing units in the settlements built in the rest of the governorates of the West Bank) and also includes bids construction for housing units in the colonies as follows: (311 housing units in the settlement of " Gilo " , 387 housing units in the settlement of " Ramat Shlomo " , and 130 housing units in the settlement of " Har Homa " ,283 units in the colony " Elkana " , and 114 units in the colony of " Ma'ale Adumim " , 196 housing units in the colony " Karni Shomron " , 102 housing units in the settlement of " Givat Ze'ev " , 18 housing units in the settlement of " Ariel " , 80 housing units in the settlement of " Givat Binyamin - Adam " , 238 housing units in the settlement of " Beitar Illit " , and 30 units in the colony " Bet El "). • <u>Obstruction on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of November 3rd 2013, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:00, a demonstration took place near Shu'fat checkpoint in Jerusalem protesting against the demolition of several homes in Ras Shihadeh and Ras Khamis neighbourhoods in Shu'fat camp, clashed with Israeli forces who fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Saffa village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Atara bridge fired tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Mo’en Allawneh (17 years old) and Mohammad Allawneh and served 3 residents: Hussein Khalayleh, Imad Kan’an and Khaled Ghanam to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. Also an Israeli military jeep rammed into a vehicle owned by Ahmad Malaysheh and as a result damaged the vehicle then withdrew at 04:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained Hatem Jabr and released him at a later time.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:45 and again at 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then released them at a later time. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Izbit Jallud village temporarily detained Diya’ Odeh (11 years old) then released him at a later time. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Azzun Atma temporarily detained Wa’el Atmawi as he was driving his truck then released him at a later time. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, an Israeli settler assaulted and sprayed pepper spray onto the face of Suliman Mohammad, a resident of Qalqiliya as he was working at a merchant shop in Al-Nabi Elisa's village and as a result leaving hospitalised from suffocation. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Far’ata village and

	<p>damaged several Olive trees owned by Mohammad Suliman.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening at 19:10 • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qussin village junction. (ii) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. (iii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sabastiya village until 21:50. (iv) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qaballan junction until 22:05. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:05, Israeli forces raided Osirin village, clashed with several residents as they stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 20:40. (ii) At dawn on November 4th 2013, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and detained 2 residents as they stormed their homes. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ayman Dawarsheh and Mu’tasim Awad in Awarta village. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces prevented several residents from collecting Olive harvest from their agricultural land in Qaryut village. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> On the morning of November 3rd 2013, Israeli forces levelled a plot of agricultural land in Qusra village owned by the heirs to Narmin Ni’ meh. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 12:10, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land near Qaryut village in Nablus, set fire to several Olive trees owned by Jamal Mustafa, a resident of Qaryut village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nashash area junction. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:50, Israeli settler stormed Husan village and damaged 40 Olive trees owned by Mansour Al-Sha'er. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp junction. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Yatta and Al-Samou'. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained 2 residents. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Rafah.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: On the afternoon of November 3rd 2013, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
