ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. Flying Checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Abu Dis and searched civilians and vehicles. At 13:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim on the Jerusalem-Jericho main road and searched civilians and vehicles.

	<p>(iii) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one on the junction to the town of ‘Anata and the other at the entrance to the village of Beit Iksa, and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: The Israeli army raided the village of Beit ‘Anan and arrested 2 civilians. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Beit ‘Anan: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mayyas Yousef al Matari; and (ii) Hani Nael Rabee’.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni’lin, Bil’in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of ‘Abud and the village of Beit Sira. • Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Silwad and the village of Yabrud and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids/Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of El Bireh and patrolled the area. (ii) At 21:45, the Israeli army, including 10 jeeps, raided the village of Kafr ‘Ein. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. The Israeli army also searched 1 house, arrested 1 female university student, and withdrew at 22:55. (iii) At 01:05, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the city of Ramallah. While patrolling the area, the Israeli army opened intensive fire. At 02:55, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Su’ad Mohammed ash Shu’aybi, a female university student, in the village of Kafr ‘Ein.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one near the settlement of Rotem in the Northern Jordan Valley area and the other on the road connecting the towns of Qabatiya and Az Zababida, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up 3 flying checkpoints: on the junction to the town of 'Arraba on the Jenin-Nablus main road; in the area between the towns of 'Arraba and Kafr Ra'i; and on the junction to the village of Al Jarba. Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of 'Arraba, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian, allegedly for locating a pistol in his possession. • <u>Raids/Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the village of Rummana, searched a number of houses, and withdrew at 05:30. (ii) At 02:30, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the village of Kafr Dan, opened intensive fire, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Arrest:</u> Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the town of 'Arraba arrested Saleh Fawzi Smoudi.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Bizzariya and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids/Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem and searched 1 house. At 22:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area until 00:20. (ii) At 13:50, Israeli Special Forces raided and patrolled Nur Shams refugee camp. (iii) At 20:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Kafr al Labad and examined the IDs of the residents of one house after forcing them outside. The Israeli army also took photographs of the house. (iv) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Anabta. (v) At 01:40, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the village of 'Izbat al Jarad. While patrolling the area, the Israeli army opened fire and fired sound grenades. At 02:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.

<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years unless accompanied by one of their parents. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction was resumed in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun. • Flying Checkpoints: At 13:45, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and the other in the area between the town of ‘Azzun and the village of An Nabi Elyas on the Qalqiliya-Nablus main road, and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raid: At 01:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the city of Qalqiliya and patrolled the area until 01:30. • Settler Violence/Physical Assault: At 17:40, a group of Israeli settlers beat Salah Jaber ‘Eid, a Palestinian National Security officer, while he was stepping out of a bus near the junction to the village of Jinsafut. As a result, ‘Eid sustained constusions.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus, as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. • Checkpoints/Detentions: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. (ii) Al Badhan checkpoint (set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) remains closed with dirt barricades. (iii) Nablus-‘Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00. (iv) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (v) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (vi) At 20:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya and detained a number of civilians.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Yitzhar and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Attack/Injury:</u> At 14:30, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya opened fire towards as well as injured Haytham Mahmoud Yaseen, a mentally challenged civilian. • <u>Raids/Detention/Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the village of ‘Azmut and arrested 4 civilians, including 2 brothers. (ii) At 22:15, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and searched 2 buildings, after detaining residents outside. At 05:15, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (iii) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided ‘Askar refugee camp and opened indiscriminate fire while it was patrolling the area. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli troops positioned at Beit Iba checkpoint arrested Mohammed ‘Izzat Jaber, a Palestinian National Security officer. <p>The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the village of ‘Azmut:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Badee’ Rayeq Thawabteh; (iii) Yasser Rayeq Thawabteh; (iv) Samer Jamal Tawabteh; and (v) ‘Azeez Sabeeh Thawabteh.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari’el. • <u>Arrest:</u> At 10:00, the Israeli army arrested Tayseer S’oud Abdullah near the town of Bruqin.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al ‘Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land,

The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs. • <u>Raids/Curfews:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Az Zubeidat and imposed curfew. Having demanded that civilians between 16 and 50 years of age leave their houses, the Israeli army searched a number of houses. At 02:55, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 02:35, the Israeli army raided the village of Marj al Ghazal, imposed curfew, and searched a number of houses after forcing residents outside. At 03:35, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of 'Ayda refugee camp, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal. • <u>Death:</u> At 06:30, Fatima Abdul Fattah Zahran, an 80-year-old female civilian, died of critical injuries sustained during the Israeli army's raid on the city of Bethlehem, as was reported on 03 November 2006. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> Israeli troops positioned at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint severely beat Mu'taz Mohammed al Hmour, leaving him with contusions. At 20:25, Al Hmour was admitted to Beit Jala Public Hospital for medical treatment. • <u>Raids:</u> At 19:45, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the city of Bethlehem. At 01:55, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of

	<p>Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was resumed in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta. • <u>Injury/Destruction of Property:</u> An Israeli army jeep travelling against the traffic direction in Ras al Jora area in the city of Hebron ran into a civilian vehicle, causing damage to the vehicle and lightly injuring its driver. • <u>Raids:</u> At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint near Hebron University, and searched civilians and vehicles. The Israeli army also searched a commercial shop. At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the city again, set up a checkpoint in the area of Ras al Jora, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. • <u>Attack on Property:</u> The Israeli army distributed notices for the cessation of construction of 8 houses in the town of Yatta. • <u>Attack on Religious Site:</u> The Israeli army delivered a notice for the demolition of a mosque in the village of At Tuwani east of the town of Yatta. • <u>School Disruption:</u> At 10:20, the Israeli army raided a basic school in Jabal Johar in the old city of Hebron, opened fire, and fired sound as well as tear gas grenades, forcing students to leave the school. • <u>Settler Violence/Injury:</u> At 10:50, an Israeli settler opened fire towards As'ad Ahmed al Qawasmeh near the town of Bani Na'im, leaving him with critical wounds. Al Qawasmeh was later transported to Hebron Public Hospital for medical treatment.

Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah.

**NORTHERN

- **Closure of Crossing Point:** Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases.
- **Incursion/Air Patrol/Attacks/Injuries/House Occupation:** Beginning at 01:20 on 01 November 2006, the Israeli army, covered by combat helicopters and reconnaissance aircraft, has continued to reinforce its presence in the town of Beit Hanun, the area of Abu Safiya, and Beit Hanun (Erez) Industrial Zone. Israeli armoured vehicles and combat helicopters continued to open intensive fire and tanks continued to fire shells towards civilian houses, killing 3 civilians, including 1 female child and 1 female civilian, as well as 1 Palestinian National Security officer and injuring 9 other civilians. The Israeli army also occupied 1 house at the southern entrance to the town of Beit Hanun and converted it into a military post. The Israeli army also searched a number of houses and demolished another house. The Israeli army remains positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning.
- **House Demolition:** The house the Israeli army demolished in the town of Beit Hanun belongs to Rabee' Nabhan.
- **Air Attacks/Injury:**
 - (i) At 10:15, an Israeli combat helicopter fired 1 missile towards the area of Sha'sha'a east of the town of Jabalya.
 - (ii) At 10:40, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards a gathering of civilians in the town of Beit Hanun, critically injuring Mohammed Rasheed al Massri.
- **Attacks/Destruction of Property:**
 - (i) At 11:55, an Israeli combat helicopter opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses east of the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu. As a result, an elderly female civilian died of a trauma.
 - (ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army fired 1 tank shell from its position on Palestinian territory towards and damaged 1 house belonging to Mohammed 'Abed Rabbu in the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu.
 - (iii) At 12:20, the Israeli army opened fire from its position on Palestinian territory towards a number of civilians in the village of Izbat 'Abed Rabbu, killing 1 child. At 14:30, the Israeli army opened fire again, killing 2 civilians (brothers). Thereby, the number of those killed rose to 3 civilians.
 - (iv) At 21:00, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards a civilian house in the area of Bir Na'ja north of the town of Beit Lahiya.
 - (v) At 00:55, the Israeli army fired 20 missile mortars from its locations inside the Green Line towards the areas of Jabal ar Rayyes and Tallet Quleibu north and east of the town of Jabalya.
 - (vi) At 02:45, the Israeli army fired 7 missile mortars from its locations inside the Green Line towards the area of Jabal ar Rayyes east of the town of Jabalya.
- **Killings:** The Israeli army killed 3 civilians and 1 Palestinian security officer in the town of Beit Hanun:
 - (i) Isra' Talal Nasser, a 13-year-old female child;
 - (ii) Dalal Shabat, a female civilian;
