JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 4th 2011 the Israeli army increased restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • Raid: On November 4th 2011, Israeli forces raided Beit Iksa, stormed a home and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Abed Elayian during their raid into Beit Iksa. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction ongoing in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Biet Ur Al-Foqa, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 12:30 and again at 01:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Atara, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Um Saffa, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 04:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr

	<p>Malek, detained a Taxi belonging to Islam Othman and thoroughly searched the vehicle and allowed him to pass at a later time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided El-Bireh city. (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun Camp, during which confrontations ensued between residents and Israeli troops. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Mazrat Al-Noubani, and served Mohammad Thiab a summon to report to Israeli intelligence. (iv) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Betunia until 02:00 • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in Nilin and Bilin against settler violence and land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction; Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the village entrance during which confrontations ensued and Israeli troops fired stun and teargas grenades towards the demonstrators. (ii) At 12:40, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in Al-Nabi Saleh against settler violence and land confiscation for the purpose of settlement expansion; Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the village entrance during which confrontations ensued between residents and Israeli troops fired stun and teargas grenades injuring , Christian Henry and others suffocated from teargas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Al-Arqa village, searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00 • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Bayda village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) At 13:00, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 09:00 the Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and at 12:45 impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces setup a flying checkpoint at Safarin village bypass road, searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village According to an Israeli High Court decision,

	the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again at 18;00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzoun, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) . (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 12;10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Eliyas village, searching civilians and vehicles. (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Imatin village and detained a resident. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces Raided Azzoun and set up a flying checkpoint and withdrew at 13;20. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddoum, stormed several homes and served summons to Bashar Shintawi (17 years Old) and Yasser Ammar to report to Israeli intelligence. (iii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Jit village and served a summon to Mohamad Seel to report to Israeli intelligence. • Detentions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Akram Qassam during their raid into Imatin. (ii) Israeli forces detained an unidentified individual during their raid into Azzoun. • Demonstrations: At 12:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in Kafr Kaddoum village protesting against the closure of eastern entrance to the village by Israeli troops, during which confrontations ensued and Israeli troops fired stun and teargas grenades towards several homes, leaving 7 residents including a child, who suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continued to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continued to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the

	<p>village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: <p>(i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00</p> <p>(ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.</p> <p>(iii) At 17:40, Israeli forced increased restrictions at Huwara checkpoint, impeding the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying checkpoints: <p>(i) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Fouriq wall gates and prevented civilians from entering or leaving the village.</p> <p>(ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(iii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Yitsahar settlement junction north of Halhul, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(iv) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance Sarah village, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(v) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Qablan village village, searching civilians and vehicles.</p>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</p> <p>(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: <p>(i) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Istia village, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: On November 4th 2011, Israeli forces detained Rashid Jabar for not reporting to Israeli intelligence agency • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Ouja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <p>(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.</p> <p>(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying checkpoint: At 07:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the south

	entrance of Jericho, searching civilians and vehicles.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Checkpoint: At 17:30 Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) . • Raids: At 10:45, Israeli special forces raided Irtas village • Detention: Israeli forces positioned at the Container checkpoint detained Thaer Harrasa, a resident of Nablus. • Demonstrations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched towards Al-Asra village in protest against the construction of the wall. (ii) At 12:15, Palestinian and international peace activists marched towards Al-WaljeH in protest against the construction of the wall. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances lead to Beit Ummar town. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Khursa village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.

	<p>(ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on Al-Shuweikeh road in Hebron's Old City, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village. (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar searched several homes and detained a civilian. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Yatta, searched a home and detained a resident. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:00, a group of Israeli settlers, under the protection of Israeli forces, raided a Muslim cemetery in Hebron's Old City and chanted Anti Arab and Muslim slogans, during which Israeli troops fired teargas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and detained a child. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Iyad Abu Mira during their raid into Beit Ummar. (ii) Israeli forces detained Wissam Abu Ramouse during their raid into Hebron's Old City. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Armed Palestinian groups broke the ceasefire agreement by firing projectiles towards targets on the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Palestinian Attack: On the evening of November 4th 2011, members of an armed Palestinian group launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
