WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeding the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Biddu and clashed with its residents.
 - (ii) On November 4th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed a home and detained a University Student.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 04:30, Israeli forces detained Taha Latayfeh during their raid into Qalandiya camp (as mentioned in the previous report).
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Thaer Mahariq, a resident of Al-Samou’ as he was in Al-Ezariya.
- **Home Demolition:** At 14:30, Israeli forces served a demolition order for a home owned by Mohammad Sara’ya for allegedly being built without a licence in Anata.
- **Killing:** On the evening of November 4th 2013, Rami Al-Zabani, a resident of Shu’fat camp in Jerusalem died of injuries sustained after being struck by a rubber coated steel bullet in the chest in 2009 and left him in Israeli hospitals with severe heart condition.
- **Attack:** At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned in Qalandiya checkpoint fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city. (ii) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Awarta, stormed and searched a home. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Mazari' Al-Nubani village, stormed several homes and summoned 2 residents: Bashar Musafir and Suhayeb Al-Nubani to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 03:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Ofar prison fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left Wajiha Mauslih suffocated and hospitalised from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed and searched several vehicle spare part shops, temporarily detained a local television crew thus preventing them from reporting the incident after deleting all recordings from the crew camera. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Sayda village, stormed a home and detained a resident. (iii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Zeita and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Alaa Hamdan in Sayda village. (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Obayda Ahmad and Samer Mir'I in Zeita. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Hajja village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village and fired stun grenades. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed several homes and detained 6 residents including a child. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Yusef Salim (17 years old), Yusef Al-Hamadi, Khalid Salim, Ahmad Salim, Ahmad Radwan and Yusef Abu Hamza in Azzun. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Azzun Atma village assaulted 2 residents: Ali Suliman and Alaa Suliman, residents of Izbit Suliman village leaving them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening at 15:50 • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita junction. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira Al-Shamaliya until 21:55. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:25, Israeli forces raided Salem village until 20:05. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Burin village until 21:30. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Hatab village until 22:00. (iv) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with its residents as they stormed several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Nidal Al-Ayadi, Hamdi Mir’I and Ahmad Abu Salayha in Nablus.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forced set up a checkpoint between Bruqin and Kafr Al-Dik. • <u>Raid:</u> At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Rafat village and set up a checkpoint • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:25, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily detained Ayman Khaled, (Palestinian Intelligence Officer) and released him at 10:05. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 near Al-Nwei'meh village junction located in North Jericho. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho. (iv) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction and temporarily detained Suliman Jarhud (A Palestinian Police officer) then released him at a later time. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
