## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya and detained two residents in Abu Dis.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) On the evening November 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa, Khalil Abu Al-Hawa and Bakr Al-Mughrabi in Al-Tur Neighbourhood.
  - (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Rida Dolah (16 years old) and Mohammad Saber in Jerusalem.
  - (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces detained four residents: Mohammad Shawki, Mohammad Joulani, Yusef Iskafi and Wadi’ Ghayth in Al-Thuri neighbourhood.
  - (iv) Israeli forces detained Raed Rabi’ and Mohammad Muhsien in Abu Dis.
- **Expulsion:** On November 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014, the Israeli Military issued an expulsion order for Shar Al-Natsheh preventing her from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 2 months.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 10:00, Israeli settlers the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers during which Israeli forces prevented worshippers under the age of 40 from entering the compound.
