- On November 4th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the (i) entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Agsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Agsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit (ii) Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-(iii) Eisawiya village with cement blocks.

- (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.
- On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with (v) Cement blocks.
- On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur (vi) neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.
- On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh (vii) area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.

#### **Checkpoints:**

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

#### Flying Checkpoint:

(i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Anata then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles.

# **JERUSALEM**

- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Al-Ram and impeded the free flow of traffic for the alleged throwing of a Molotov fire bomb towards an Israeli military bus.
- <u>Detention</u>: At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint detained Jihad Jabr Muhisein.
- Attack: At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at the North junction of Anata fired stun
  and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the
  protection of the Israeli Military and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in
  the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages
- (ii) . On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) At 22:00 on November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Silwad with Cement blocks.
- (iv) At 09:00 on November 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North East entrance of Ain Yabrud village with Cement blocks and dirt mounds.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illo village then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles.
- (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At dawn on November 4<sup>th</sup> 2015 and again at 01:00 on November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh, detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Ein Sinyiya village, stormed a gas station, confiscated surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 14:45.
- (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home then withdrew at 05:35.
- (iv) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed several homes then withdrew at 04:45.
- (v) At 05:20, Israeli forces raided Mazari' Al-Nubani village, stormed a home and summoned Abdel-Rahim Samir Al-Shalabi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (vi) At 06:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh village and detained a National Security Force officer.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained two residents: Mo'ayad Abdel-Karim Mohammad Makhlouf and Torki Thiyab Zaware' in Al-Bireh city.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Nidal Hussien Al-Tamimi in Al-Nabi Saleh village.

#### • Attack:

(i) At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate Flying Checkpoint: At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun then inspected resident's identification cards and searched vehicles. Raid: (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Fanduq village then stormed and searched several merchant shops. (ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, fired stun and tear gas grenades as they **QALQILIYA** stormed two homes and detained a National Security Force officer. **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Wael Al-Hajj Hussien in Oalgiliya. **Temporary Detention:** At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Azzun temporarily detained Abdel-Rahim Billal Radwan (A National Security Force Officer) then released him after destroying his cellular telephone. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Closure: Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and At 22:00 on October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta (iii) village with dirt mounds. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village junction located along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles until 13:00. **NABLUS** (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Huwara then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles until 15:30. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction

then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles. (iv) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jama'in then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles until 20:20.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.

# (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles until 14:0
- (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then inspected resident's identification cards and searched vehicles until 13:30.
- (iii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur then inspected resident's identification cards and searched vehicles until 12:20.
- (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles until 15:30.
- (v) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahour then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles until 15:55.

#### Raid:

#### **BETHLEHEM**

- (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, stormed Sa'id Al-Assi Secondary School, verbally warned teachers against student stone throwing then again at 12:25 clashed with several residents, detained a child and then withdrew at 13:50.
- (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Nasser Al-Barmil (16 years old) in Al-Khader.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Minah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and occupied Raed Mohamamd Al-Faroukh's home and converted its rooftop into a military post then temporarily detained the child: Mohammad Ibrahim Abdel-Majid Qawazbah (10 years old) then released him at 18:30.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

#### **HEBRON**

- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- (vii)At 05:50, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading to Far'sh Al-Hawa area located in North Hebron with dirt mounds.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up four checkpoints at Beit Einoun village, Al-Fuwar camp junctions, the entrances to Dura and A Fa'hs area located in south Hebron and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel gate entrance.
- (ii) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints in Wadi Qabbun area located in North Hebron and at the North, entrance of Hebron located

- (along bypass road 35 near Halhoul bridge) then inspected resident's identification cards and searched vehicles.
- (iii) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Yunis area junction located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem and prevented residents under the age of 30 years old from exiting Hebron.
- (iv) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhoul Bridge then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles.
- (v) At 05:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction then inspected residents Identification cards and searched vehicles.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Yatta village, stormed and searched two homes, detained a child then withdrew at 02:45.
- (ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 05:30.
- <u>Killing:</u> At 16:00, Ibrahim Samir Ibrahim Sakafi (23 years old) was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near Al-Huwar area junction located at the north entrance of Halhoul for allegedly attempting to run over 2 Israeli soldiers with his vehicle {As alleged by the Israeli Military} during which they clashed with several residents and detained a resident.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 02:30 on November 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Issa Ayash during their raid into Al-Fuwar camp in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) On November 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Marwan Wahid Hanini (A resident of Halhoul).
- (iii) Israeli forces detained the child: Assef Munthir Teim Shartih (14 years old) in Yatta.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Nidal Mohammad Khalil Madiya in Al-Huwar area located at the north entrance of Halhoul.
- Attack: At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 00:15, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted residents and attacked homes in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

### ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Khan Yunis
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by launching tank artillery shells towards Central Gaza and as a result injured a resident.

### NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
