WEST BANK

The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up **ALL** on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the **DISTRICTS** northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Agsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to (a) Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-(b) Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt (c) barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. **JERUSALEM** Raids: (i) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Abu Dis, opened fire and fired light bombs during house search, and arrested one civilian. The Israeli army raided the village of Biddo and searched on house. (ii) Arrests: The civilian arrested in the town of Abu Dis is Fadi al-Ghazawi. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu (i) Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall (ii) gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-

Jaba' road, the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west

of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.

Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern (i) entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western (ii) entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. Flying Checkpoints: At 13:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of Beit Wima and the village of al-Nabi Saleh. Raids: At 17:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of al-Bireh. The (i) raid recurred at 00:20, during which the Israeli army searched one building and arrested one civilian. At 22:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Mazra'ah (ii) an-Gharbiyyeh. Arrests: The civilian arrested in the city of al-Bireh is Zakaria Hamad al-Nahhas. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Oaddis. Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to close Tayaseer checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the village of (i) 'Anza and Ijjah, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 13:30, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints at the southern entrance to the city of Jenin and at the junction of the village of al-Kfir, and **JENIN** searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of 'Anza, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 22:20, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the town of (iv) Qabatia and the village of Misliyyeh. At 00:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the towns of al-(v) Zababdeh and Iqaba, and searched civilians and vehicles. (vi) At 01:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the town of Tamon, and searched civilians and vehicles. (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of al-Far'a. At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin and opened fire (ii)

during search of 8 houses. In addition, the Israeli army arrested a

	military officer from the Palestinian National Security Forces. The raid recurred at 02:00 during which the Israeli army raided the city until 03:00.
	(iii) At 15:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Tayaseer.
	(iv) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Toubas.
	(v) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Jalqamous and searched 4 houses.
	(vi) At 02:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Qabatia and opened indiscriminate fire during patrol.
	• Arrests:
	(i) At 01:00 on November 5, the Israeli army arrested in a raid on the city of Jenin civilian Mouayyad Istitiyyeh.
	(ii) The military officer arrested in the city of Jenin is Fadi Mohammad Jalamneh.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
	Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a
	 closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil's plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun's plain; and the entrance to the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish.
TULKAREM	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). At 17:00, the Israeli army denied civilians between the age of 16 and 35 access through the 'Einav checkpoint.
	 Raids: (i) At 11:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and patrolled it until 12:45.
	(ii) At 22:45, the Israeli army raided the suburb of Shweiki in the city of Tulkarem and patrolled it until 23:30.
	(iii) The Israeli army raided the town of Anabta where confrontations with civilians broke out during patrol.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
	• Closure of Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural
QALQILIYA	roads east of the town of 'Azzun as well as the road that connects the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib. (ii) The Israeli army closed the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun
	with an iron gate.
	• Flying Checkpoints: At 10:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction

of the village of Jeet and detained 8 military officers from the Palestinian National Security forces but released them at a later time.

• Raids:

- (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Azzun, imposed curfew, and fired tear gas bombs inside the Secondary School for Boys, which forced pupils to leave school. In addition, the Israeli army blocked the road leading to the town of Kafr Thulth and arrested one civilian.
- (ii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Jayyous.
- (iii) At 02:15, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqilya, arrested 3 civilians and withdrew at 04:00.

• Arrests:

- (i) The civilian arrested in the town of 'Azzun is Jaafar Sami Adwan.
- (ii) The 3 civilians arrested in the city of Qalqilya are;
- (a) Mohammad Khaled al-Hotari;
- (b) Nour Ahmad al-Jueidi; and
- (c) Ibrahim Youssef Maskawi.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 14:00, a bunch of settlers set fire to agricultural land near the village of Jeet, and stoned civilian vehicles on Nablus-Qalqilya road.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Land leveling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to block the roads leading to the town of al-Jama'een with dirt barricades.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:
- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.
- (ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.
- (iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close

- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 15:40, the Israeli army set up 2 checkpoints near the junction of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah, and near the junction of Vered Yeriho settlement on the southern entrance to the city of Jericho.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem.
- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 12:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem). The checkpoint was set up again at 20:00, and the Israeli army searched civilians and vehicles.

• <u>Raids</u>:

- (i) At dawn on November 5, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and arrested one civilian.
- (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, searched one house and arrested one child.
- (iii) At 03:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.
- (iv) At 05:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the refugee camp of al-Dheisheh
- (v) At 05:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Marah Rabah, searched a number of houses, and handed a number of civilians orders to see the Israeli intelligence.
- <u>Injuries</u>: At 14:10, child Zayd Falah Rashaydeh, 15, was injured as a result of Israeli army UXO explosion near Matirda military camp in the area of Arab al-Rashayda east of the city of Bethlehem.

• Arrests:

- (i) The civilian arrested in the town of Beit Fajjar is Ali Na'eem Taqatqa.
- (ii) The civilian arrested in the city of Bethlehem is Sanad Ammar Hamza, 14.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the

HEBRON	Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street. Flying Checkpoints: At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance of the road of Wadi al-Qaff t

- (ii) The Palestinian Legislative member civilian arrested in the city of Hebron is Hatem Rabah Qafeesheh.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 18:20, a bunch of settlers from Karmi Tsur settlement attacked 5 civilians working in the agricultural land near the settlement. A fist fight broke out, and at once the Israeli army intervened and evacuated the settlers and detained 5 civilians but released them at a later time.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
