• Closure:

- (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Raid:** At 16:50, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with its residents.
- **Home Demolition:** On November 5th 2013, Israeli forces demolished a home owned by Salameh Abu Taroush in south Jerusalem for allegedly being built without a licence despite the fact the home was built before the year 1967.

• Attack:

- (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in near the wall gate in Qutna village fired rubber coated steel bullets towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured Yusef Taha (13 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Kabseh area located between Abu Dis and Al-Eiziriya fired rubber coated steel bullets towards several residents for alleged stoning

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya

- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

Raid:

- (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, set up a checkpoint, temporarily detained 2 residents including an Intelligence officer: Suliman Abu Aliya and Mohammad Al-Masr them released them at a later time.
- (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several children in Ayda camp for alleged stoning.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 22:05, Israeli forces served a demolition order for the demolition of a home owned by Ayad Farah Ayad in Beit Sahur.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May $1^{\rm st}$ 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village

which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

(vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Flying checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
- (iii)At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabbun area located in north Hebron.
- (iv)At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction.

Raid:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta.
- (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp , stormed and searched 2 homes.

• Detention:

- (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shuhada' raod in the old city of Hebron detained Mahmoud Idris after being assaulted and injured by Israeli settlers.
- (ii) On the evening of November 5th 2013, Israeli forces detained Alla Abu Triqa after storming and searching his home in the old city of Hebron.
- <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of November 5th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades toward several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Assault on Education Sector:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces stormed Tariq Bin Zayed school in the old city of Hebron then withdrew at a later time.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On November 5th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed land in east Hebron, levelled 8 dunums (8 acres) of land owned by Al-Tamimi family.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Rafah.

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

	 Attack: At 21:30 on November 4th 2013, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Al-Ahmar and Al-Qatabniya areas located in east Beit Hanun
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010,
	 the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Raid: At 06:00, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 200m into the vicinity if Al-Zaytouneh neighbourhood and levelled a plot of land.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Attack: On the morning of November 6th 2013, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards the vicinity of Sufa crossing in north east Rafah.
