JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:00 on November 5th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained three residents. • <u>Killing:</u> On the afternoon of November 5th 2014, Ibrahim AlAkari (A resident of Shu’fat camp) was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him after he had ran over several Israeli settlers with his vehicles and as a result killed one Israeli soldier and injured 13 Israeli settlers near the rail station in Al-Sheikh Jarah neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shu’afat camp in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:00, Israeli force positioned near the north junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Fadi Salamiya. (iv) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hizma Ram fired

rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(v) At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Shiekh Anbar area of Al-Shiekh Jarah neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(vi) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Kabsa junction in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning

(vii) At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Al-Zahara gate (An entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(viii) At 00:35, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

(i) At 03:00 on November 5th 2014, Israeli forces detained five residents: Mohammad Za'ir, Suliman Al-Sayad, Ayoub Abu Al-Hawa, Baha Abu Al-Hawa and Mohamd Bakr Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur and Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhoods.

(ii) At 01:45 on November 5th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Badr and Mohammad Halabiya in Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya.

(iii) At 02:00 on November 5th 2014, Israeli forces detained Zaghoul Al-Shuweiky in Al-Thur neighbourhood.

(iv) At 09:20, Israeli forces detained two residents: Kathim Abu Ramouz and Sharif Abu Maliya in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood.

(v) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained three residents: Tarik Al-Halmous (An "Islamic WAQF" employee), Omar Al-Dawabi and Firas Al-Jab'a.

(vi) At 17:00, Israeli forces detained five residents: Husam Ghuniem, Amin Qirish, Farouq Hijazi, Foad Jafar and Omar Al-Killani in the old city of Jeriaslem.

(vii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Yusef Al-Dari, Mohammad Obied and Mohammad Al-Ghazawi in Al-Eisawiya.

- **Home Demolition:** At 08:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Tur neighbourhood and demolished a home (under construction) owned by Hassan Al-Hadara for allegedly being built without a licence.

- **Destruction of Property:** At 08:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Tur neighbourhood and demolished a barracks owned by Mohammad Abu Jum'a for allegedly being built without a licence.

- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 08:00, Israeli settlers the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from entering the compound during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards worshipers inside Al-Aqsa mosque as they attempted to prevent Israeli settlers from storming the mosque during which OIsraeli forces entered Al-Qibli mosque and fired tear gas grenades and as a result set fire to carpet and several electronic equipment inside and also injured 10 residents including a woman and a journalist: Lo'ay Abu Irmeleh (A journalist), Sabrin Obidat (a journalist), Shamiya Abu Sbieh, Thaer Abu Sbieh, Hamza Ajaj, Nihad Za'ir, Rabi' Al-Satad, Ibrahim Abu Gharbiya, Awad Al-Salamiya and Midhat Jabr as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation..

- **Wall Gates:**

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:35. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Oday Aliyan and Mohammad Sharaaqeh in Al-Jalazoun camp. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:55, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road near Al-Jalazoun camp.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin camp. (ii) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, detained 3 residents including a child then withdrew at 04:35. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Khaled Abu Bakr (17 years old), Mahdi Hamarsheh and Yaha Hamarsheh in Ya’bad.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusoun then withdrew at 18:10. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Sal’it” settlement levelled 40 dunumes (acres) of agricultural land in Kafr Qaddum village, which is located behind the wall gate and owned by Khaled Abdel-Qadder, Ibrahim Al-Mudalal and the families of Harb, Al-Zabada and Taya.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 21:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:15. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 10:45. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Madma and Burin, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Hani Al-Qut (A resident of Madma village) and Suliman Aqddus (A resident of Burin).

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Container checkpoint, fired stun grenades towards several residents and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30 and again at 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 00:30. <p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.

(vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 09:20.
- (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hebron.
- (iii) At 19:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint Beit Einun village and wadi Qabun located in north Hebron until 19:45.
- (iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Farsh Al-Hawa area located in North Hebron, assaulted Mohammad Tumayzi (A resident of Ithna) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 10:20 and again at 23:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- (ii) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Ulla and set up a checkpoint.
- (iii) At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Dura until 17:00.
- (iv) At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp (for the alleged running over of three Israeli soldiers near the camp), stormed several homes and confiscated surveillance camera tapes located near the camp entrance.
- (v) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and detained four residents (relatives of the suspected individual who ran over 3 Israeli soldiers near the entrance of Al-Urub camp).

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained four residents: Mohammad Masalmeh, Issa Masalmeh, Subhi Masalmeh and Isail Masalmeh in Beit Awa.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Tabaqa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 07:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Home Demolition:** At 15:30, Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Khier village located in east Yatta and demolished several tenets and residential barracks owned by Suliman Al-Hathalin for allegedly being built without a licence after assaulting and injuring him.

- **Land Levelling:** At 10:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Kasrah area in east Hebron city and levelled a plot of agricultural land owned by Hajjah family.
