JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu’fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Anata, served military orders to halt construction on a building and a carwash lot owned by Jamal Abu Halaweh and Zakariya Musa for allegedly being built without a licence.</li> <li>(iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya until 21:10.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents including a child: Mohammad Assa’id (17 years old), Waleed Ghannam and Mohammad Abu Hadwan in Jerusalem.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces detained Ghalib Sami Hassan Al-Nis (A resident of Nahalin village in Bethlehem).</li> <li>(iii) At 19:40, Israeli forces detained Tamara Mu’amar Abu Labban (15 years old) after storming her family home in Al-Tur neighbourhood.</li> <li>(iv) On the evening of November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Jihad Al-Ja’bari and Mohammad Al-Rashq after storming their homes in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and road # 35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (35) & (60) junctions located in North Hebron then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- (iii) At 16:15 and again at 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Halhoul bridge then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- (iv) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Al-Huwawer area located in North Halhoul) and at Al-Nabi Yunis junction located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards and prevented residents and vehicles from using bypass road (60).
- (v) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Wadi Sa'ir road then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- (vi) At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.

- **Raid:**

- (i) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident.
- (ii) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya and detained two residents including a child.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 00:40 on November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Baha Waleed Al-Sa'ed during their raid into Yatta in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) On November 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents: Amjad Khaled Abu Rajjab, Ahmad Abu Rajjab and Shadi Yusef Abu Rajjab as they were collecting Olive harvest near Zif village junction.
