## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
  - (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, clashed with its residents as they stormed several homes, detained a resident, temporarily detained Samer Abu Zied (Palestinian Intelligence Officer) then released him at a later time.
  - (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Anabta, stormed and searched a home.
- **Obstruction of Places of Worship:** At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem, provoked several worshipers then Israeli forces assaulted several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault and as a result injured Nada Abu Afeyeh and detained assaulted another resident after detaining him as he attempted to prevent the assault.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces detained Musa Al-Akhrasas they stormed an internet café in the old city of Jerusalem.
  - (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Rakan, Issa Kharfoush and Rami Barakat as they stormed a computer store in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem.
  - (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ibrahim Shoukat and Jallal Shukat in Jerusalem.
  - (iv) At 20:30, Israeli forces detained Majed Al-Jam’a in Bab Al-Salasleh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
  - (v) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained Abu Musa Dweikat in Sur Bahar village.

	<p>(vi) At 22:00, Israeli forces detained Khalil Al-Ghazawi as they stormed his home in Al-Thur neighbourhood in Jerusalem and confiscated a computer.</p> <p>(vii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Arnaout in Al-Eizariya.</p> <p>(viii) Israeli forces detained Ikram Al-Sharfa in Al-Aqsa mosque compound in Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.</li> </ul>

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

- **Flying checkpoint:**

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dura.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 09:00 and again at 00:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Ulla and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa.
- (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 05:50.
- (iv) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:55.
- (v) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with its residents as they stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then summoned 3 residents: Issam Abu Hashim , Mohammad Abu Mariya and Habis Abu Mariy to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 03:00 on November 6<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces detained Alla Abu Turki after storming his home in Abu Snieme neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Rami Al-Sarahin and Mohammad Al-Sarahin.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Sil in Al-Urub camp.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Yusef Hashim in Beit Ummar.

- **Temporary Detention:**

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 children: Yusef Salhab (12 years old) and Abed Salhab (13 years old) in the old city of Hebron and released them at a later time.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained Abed Al-Rahman Burqan (10 years old) in the old city of Hebron and released him at a later time.
- (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad Ghazaleh (16 years old) near Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron and released him at a later time.

- **Attack:** On the evening of November 6<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades toward several residents for alleged stoning.
