• Closure:

- (i) On October 30th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.
- (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 13:10, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho Districts and impeded the free flow of traffic {after a Israeli settler was injured after a Molotov fire bombing was thrown towards a settler vehicle as it passed near Hizma village as alleged by the Israeli military} then reopened it at a later time.

• Detention:

- (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at "Remi Levi" shopping Centre located in Mukhmas village detained Yusef Jubran Awwawdeh {A resident of Deir Dibwan.
- (ii) At 22:35, Israeli forces positioned near Abu Dis detained the child Moath Issa Ali Radaydeh (16 years old) {A resident of Al-Obidiya village in Bethlehem} after they assaulted him.

Attack:

- (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint and at the entrance of Hizma fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jabal area junction in Abu Dis fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala: Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" (ii) settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Tagou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement
- Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iii)
- Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area (iv) in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and (v) road 60 with dirt mounds.
- Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to (vi) 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with (vii) dirt mounds.
- On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of (viii) Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily
- Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road (ix) located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.

Flying Checkpoint:

(i) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Jallah and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:20.

BETHLEHEM

- (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at entrance of Asakra village then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 11:10.
- (iii) At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- (iv) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.

• Raid:

- (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with several residents and as a result, left family members of Mohammad Fihmi Hamza suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 14:20.
- (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Betar village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:15.
- (iv) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village, summoned Habib Mohammad Omar Al-Shiekh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:30.
- (v) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, summond Hamza Ebieat to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (vi) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed two homes and summoned Mahmoud Farhan Dariya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.

• Attack:

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Mahmoud Immad Abdel-Ghanni Salhab (17 years old), Jamil Khader Jamil Al-Ba'abish and Bara' Mahmoud Zaboun and also stormed of Billal Bin Rabah mosque and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Beit Fajjar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem detained Hisham Mujahid Ali Al-Saga (23 years old).

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

HEBRON

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- (vii)At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
- (viii) At 15:00 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bani Na'im in Wadi Al-Juz area with cement blocks and closed the steel gate entrance leading to the south entrance of Dura.
- (ix) At 12:35 on November 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading to Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron and the entrance of Beit Anoun.
- (x) On November 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Hebron near by pass road (35) near Halhoul Bridge.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (60) near "Kharsina "settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic then searched residents and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron near by pass road (35) near Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Fuwar camp near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron then searched residents and vehicles.
- (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Yunis area junction located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem then searched residents and vehicles.

• Raid:

- (i) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Ras Al-Jora neighbourhood in Hebron and temporarily detained three journalists inside a building in the area then released them at 16:50.
- (ii) At 18:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Einoun village (for the alleged gunfire towards a Israeli settler which left him critically injured as alleged by the Israeli Military), then stormed and searched several homes and questioned several residents.
- (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, clashed with several residents, stormed two homes and summoned Ahnath Yusef Faroukh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im, clashed with several residents after storming and searching four homes, detained a resident, confiscated a hunting rifle then withdrew at 23:25.
- <u>Killing:</u> At 13:00, Tharwat Ibrahim Salim Al-Sha'rawi (73 years old) {A resident of Hebron} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards her inside a gas station in Ras Al-Jorah neighbourhood in Hebron {for allegedly attempting to run over a Israeli soldier as alleged by the Israeli military} and as a result also injured 2 workers

- at the gas station: Ehab Kamal Khalil Badawi and Mahmoud Yusef Mohammad Zama'rah and also confiscated surveillance camera footage from the gas station.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Moath Daoud Manasra and Maen Daoud Manasra in Bani Na'im.

• Attack:

- (i) At 12:35, Israeli forces positioned near Halhoul bridge fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including 4 children: Mohammad Abdel-Salam Al-Asseli (14 years old), Ahed Munthir Sabarneh (17 years old), Imad Fayez Rabah Obiedo (17 years old), Nour Al-Din Ziyad Sbitani (17 years old) and Rashed Mohammad Abu Rayan as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp and at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned near Tariq Bin Ziyad junction in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Awwa fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned near Abu Sneneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained Dr. Majed Ghanam as he was travelling in his vehicle along the main road between Beit Ummar and Haloul for allegedly unsettling a group of Israeli settlers then released him at a later time.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Salaymeh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and detonated and destroyed entrance doors for three homes owned by Samer Abu Rajjab, Kamal Salaymeh and Raed Abu Irmeleh as they stormed and searched the homes.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 11:10, Israeli forces stormed the old city of Hebron and surrounded "Wasaya Al-Rasoul" Mosque and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers and fired live ammunition towards worshipers inside the mosque and as a result injured 5 residents including a child: Muhyi Al-Din Abu Turki (13 years old), Loia Mustafa Sadr, Mohammad Attalah Abu Snenieh, Azmi Azzam Al-Rajabi and Shadi Salah Abu Sneineh leaving them hospitalised then withdrew at 12:00.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 18:10, a group of Israeli settlers located in Wadi Al-Hassin and Jabr Wadi Al-Nassar neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron stoned several homes including the home of Samih Nu'man Shuqri Da'na and slandered several residents.
- (ii) At 24:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and chanted anti-Arab slogan and racist's slurs.

 At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by

	 the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result killed a resident and injured 19 others. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Attack: At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents near Beit Hanoun (Erez) crossing located in north Beit Hanoun as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result injured 4 including a journalist and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. At 00:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired live ammunition stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents located in the vicinity of Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing in east Gaza fired tear gas grenades towards several residents in North Beit Lahiya Jabaliya as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result and injured 5 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Al-Buriej camp Jabaliya as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result injured 7 residents and left 4 others suffocated from tear gas inhalatio
KHAN YUNIS	 Attack: At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Al-Farahin rea located in east Abbassan Al-Kabirah as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound as a result killed a resident, injured 3 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. Killing: Israeli forces killed Salameh Musa Abu Jama' (23 years old) {A resident of Al-Zanah area located in Bani Sahila}.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing closed.
