WEST BANK

ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

• <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
- Flying Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints near the junctions to the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and the area of Al Khan al Ahmar on the Jerusalem-Jericho main road and searched civilians and vehicles.
- <u>Raid</u>: At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Duqqu. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians.

House Demolition: The Israeli army demolished 1 house belonging to 'Imad al Ja'bari in the town of 'Anata, claiming that it was built without the required licence. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern (i) entrance to the village of Sinjil. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western (ii) entrance to the village of Saffa. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. **Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:** (i) On the dawn of 07 November 2006, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Mughayyir and arrested 5 civilians. At 16:00, Israeli Special Forces, supported by 10 Israeli army jeeps, (ii) raided the city of Ramallah, after having demanded (through the DCO) RAMALLAH that Palestinian security forces not leave their positions. Confrontations & also took place between the Israeli army and civilians. In addition, the EL BIREH Israeli army raided a coffee shop and arrested 2 civilians as well as 2 Palestinian security officers. At 23:00, the Israeli army, including 10 jeeps, raided the city of El (iii) Bireh and patrolled the area until 23:30. The Israeli army raided the village of Abu Falah and arrested 2 (iv) civilians. **Arrests**: At 14:30, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up on the (i) overpass to the town of 'Atara arrested Sami Hani Thaher, a Palestinian Police officer. The Israeli army arrested 5 civilians in the village of Al Mughayyir: 'Odeh Fat'hi Abu 'Ilayya; (ii) (iii) Jawdat Yousef Abu 'Ilayya; Sameer Mohammed Abu 'Ilayya; (iv) Khamis Mohammed Abu 'Ilayya; and (v) Mustafa Ahmed Abu 'Ilayya. (vi) The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians and 2 Palestinian security officers in the city of Ramallah: Mahmoud Suleiman al 'Arouri, a Palestinian security officer; (vii) Mifleh Abdul Ghafer Hasan, a Palestinian security officer; (viii)

	 <u>Closure of Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.
	Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.
	 Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, and the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Raids: At 14:40, an Israeli army patrol raided the town of Zeita, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 16:00, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp. At 02:15, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the village of 'Izbat al Jarad, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 03:00.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to school students under 16 years unless accompanied by one of their parents. Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. Raids: At 22:10, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Azzun and searched 2 houses. At 23:35, Israeli Special Forces, supported by 6 Israeli army jeeps, raided the city of Qalqiliya and searched a number of houses. The Israeli army also arrested 4 civilians as well as 1 Palestinian Preventive Security officer and 1 Palestinian General Intelligence officer. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians and 2 Palestinian security officers in the city of Qalqiliya:

	 (i) Miqdam Ibrahim Jabr, a Palestinian Preventive Security officer; (ii) Waleed Yousef al 'Athbeh, a Palestinian General Intelligence officer; (iii) Samer 'Azmi Zeid; (iv) Lu'ay Ahmed Hasayen; (v) Hashem Abdul Kareem Sabri; and (vi) Mahmoud Yousef Milhem.
NABLUS	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus, as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. Al Badhan checkpoint (set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) remains closed with dirt barricades. Nablus-'Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00. At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and denied access to civilians holding Jenin- and Tulkaremissued IDs who are between 16 and 45 years of age. At 13:40, the Israeli army closed Beit Iba checkpoint and denied civilian access, claiming to have arrested a civilian who was in possession of live ammunition. At 14:00, the Israeli army reopened the checkpoint. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:30, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one in the area between the villages of Talluza and Al Badhan and the other on the road to the village of Majdal Bani Fadil leading to the Jordan Valley area. Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints searched civilians and vehicles. Arrests: (i) At 12:30, Israeli troops pos
SALFIT	• Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western

	entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • Checkpoints: (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Bruqin on the Trans-Samaria Highway and searched civilians and vehicles.
JERICHO	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah and searched civilians and vehicles. Raid: At 10:45, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the village of Fasayil and searched a number of houses.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the "Container") checkpoint and to deny access to civilian vehicles, except for those possessing access permits. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, north of 'Ayda refugee camp, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal. Raids/Physical Assaults/Detentions: (i) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Tuqu' and detained 2 civilians after having beaten them. The Israeli army released the

- detained civilians at a later time. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town again, searched 3 houses, and arrested 3 civilians.
- (ii) At 01:05, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Bethlehem and patrolled the area.
- (iii) At 01:15, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the town of Beit Fajjar and patrolled the area until 03:00.
- (iv) At 02:25, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the village of Harmala and patrolled the area until 03:50.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the town of Tuqu':
- (i) Nidhal Hasan al 'Umour;
- (ii) Kamel Abdullah al Badan; and
- (iii) Mohammed 'Abed Sabah.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 09:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one on the overpass to the town of Halhul and the other at the entrance to Al Fawwar refugee camp, and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

(i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron and searched a number of houses in the areas of Dweirban and 'Issa. At 16:30, the

- Israeli army raided the city again and searched 2 houses in Khallet Hadur.
- (ii) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Adh Dhahiriya.
- (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of Tarqumiya and arrested 1 civilian.

• Arrests:

- (i) At 01:40 on 07 November 2006, the Israeli army arrested Zuheir Hasan al Hroub during its raid on the town of Dura, in addition to those reported yesterday.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested Abdullah Mustafa Qa'qour in the town of Tarqumiya.
- <u>Settler Violence/Attack/Injury</u>: At 12:00, an Israeli settler from the settlement of Kiryat Arba' in the old city of Hebron opened fire towards and injured Hasan Hassoun al Ja'bari.

ALL DISTRICTS	Beginning on 25 June 2006, the Israeli army has reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the northern and eastern borders of the district of Northern Gaza. Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah.		
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases. Air Attack/Injury: At 13:40, an Israeli UAV fired 1 missile towards a gathering of civilians near Jabal ar Rayyes east of the town of Jabalya, critically injuring 14-year-old Abdul Kareem Qaddas. Attacks/Injuries/Destruction of Property/Air Patrols: At 09:35, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards 1 house in the area of Sha'sha'a east of the town of Jabalya, killing 3 civilians, including 2 female civilians, and gravely damaging the house. At 09:55, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards 1 house on As Sikka Street east of the town of Jabalya, killing 1 civilian, injuring another, and gravely damaging the house. At 10:25, the Israeli army fired 3 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards 1 house in the area of Tallet al Kashef east of the town of Jabalya, gravely damaging the house. At 11:00, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards the area of As Sudaniya, killing 1 civilian. At 11:25, the Israeli army opened fire from its position on Palestinian territory towards a number of civilians north the horsemanship club, injuring 1 civilian. 		

- (vi) At 11:55, the Israeli army opened fire from its position on Palestinian territory towards a number of civilians near Ash Shuhada' Cemetery east of the town of Jabalya, injuring 1 civilian.
- (vii) At 12:35, the Israeli army opened fire from its position on Palestinian territory towards a number of civilians near the American School in the town of Beit Lahiya, injuring a number of civilians. At 15:15, the Israeli army opened fire again towards the area.
- (viii) At 12:40, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards a number of civilians near Ad Durra Hospital as well as near Jabal al Kashef east of the town of Jabalya.
- (ix) At 13:30, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards civilian houses as well as towards the offices of a Palestinian National Security Headquarters east of the town of Jabalya.
- (x) At 17:40, the Israeli army fired 15 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory in the area surrounding the College of Agriculture in the town of Beit Hanun.
- (xi) At 22:05, the Israeli army fired 1 missile mortar and 1 artillery shell from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory in the area surrounding the American School in the town of Beit Lahiya.
- (xii) At 06:00, the Israeli army fired 11 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards civilian houses in the town of Beit Hanun, killing 18 civilians, including children and women, and injuring 40 others, including children and women. Among these, several civilians were in critical condition. The Israeli attack also caused damage to 10 civilian houses.
- (xiii) At 06:30, the Israeli army fired 1 missile mortar from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards a group of armed Palestinian individuals near Jabal ar Rayyes east of the town of Jabalya, injuring 6 armed individuals.

• Raids/Attacks/Injuries/House Occupations:

- (i) Beginning at 09:00 on 05 November 2006, the Israeli army remained positioned on Palestinian territory north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. An armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals near the American School. The Israeli army also fired a number of tank shells near the area of Al 'Atatira, killing 2 Palestinian security officers and injuring 4 civilians, including 1 child. In addition, the Israeli army occupied 2 houses in the area of Al 'Atatira, converted them into military posts, and opened fire towards civilians, injuring 1 civilian.
- (ii) At 10:40, the Israeli army, including 5 armoured vehicles and 1 bulldozer, raided Palestinian territory and took position near the village of 'Izbat 'Abed Rabbu, near the area of Sha'sha'a, and on Salah ad Din main road east of the town of Jabalya. An armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals near Hamuda gas station. Additionally, the Israeli army fired 2 tank shells towards a gathering of civilians on As Sikka Street, injuring 8 civilians.
- Killings: The Israeli army killed 3 civilians in the area of Sha'sha'a east of

	the town of Jabalya:
	(i) Nahlah ash Shanti, a female civilian;
