JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 7th 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 35 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and detained four residents including a child. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including 2 children and a paramedic: Yusef Farhan (16 years old), Omar Orabi (15 years old), Yusef Abdel-Qadder (A Paramedic), Abdel-Mu’ti Abu Sneneh, Munthir Manasrah, Mohammad Attalah, Ashraf Matour and Yusef Abdel-Qadder. (iii) At 12:55, Israeli forces positioned near the north junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Khaled Al-Bassati (15 years old) (iv) At 13:10 and again at 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 13:15 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Anata

(ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Saber Obied (15 years old), Rami Darwish, Haytham Mahmoud and Salah Al-Jadari in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On November 7th 2014, Israeli forces served a military order for the confiscation of 214 dunumes /acres of land in Biddu, Beit Surik, Qutna villages and Khirbeit Ghalous for alleged military purposes. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 11:30, on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Bet El Settlement located near Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iv) At 10:50, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Abboud with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud. (iii) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 7 residents including 5 children: Khalil Hillis (14 years old), Ahmad Al-Ramahi (17 years old), Mohammad Khattab (17 years old), Qassim Abu Adib (16 years old), Yusef Farhan

(ii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured an International Peace Activist (French National) and left several others suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bardala village. • <u>House Demolition:</u> On the 5th of November 2014, Israeli Forces demolished 7 homebuilt of tents and Baraks located in the village of Bardala. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces stormed east Tubas city and served an eviction order for a plot of land owned by Ahmad Al-Khatib. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces nine families from their homes in Ras Al-Hamra area in Tubas from 12:00 November 9th 2014 until 12:00 November 12th 2014 so that Israeli forces can conduct military exercises.

(iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. (iv) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Nabi Eliyas village and the agricultural road located between Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:10, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:30 • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Rujieb village junction until 11:00. (ii) At 10:15 and again at 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 23:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near “Bagha” settlement located in south Nablus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Yazan Hindi (17 years old), Khaled Al-Habash and Ra’fat Al-Nouri (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned at Jabal Jadou’ area located south of “Yitmar” settlement fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Huwara checkpoint and attacked residents nad vehicles as they were passing through the checkpoint then withdrew at 15:00.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 09:00. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured a resident.
