<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 7th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya until 04:50. (ii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqqu village, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:55. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Muntasir Darra Fadil Thiyab in Beit Duqqu village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Silwad and Ein Yabroud village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sinya village junction then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 10:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Wajih Ibrahim Wajih Muslih and Mohammad Ibrahim Wajih Muslih in Beituniya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound)for alleged stoning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 residents: Khalil Ismail Al-Tamimi and Mu'tasim Abdallah Al-Tamimi {Both are residents of Deir Naithim village } then released them at a later time
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces closed Tayassir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:45.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:05, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:20.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’mān: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Jinata then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards. (iii) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahour then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 20:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:55. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Taqou' and clashed with several residents. (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Za'tara until 02:30. (iv) At 05:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem and clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Omar Mohammad Daoud in Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:05, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- (vii) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
- (viii) At 15:00 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bani Na'im in Wadi Al-Juz area with cement blocks and closed the steel gate entrance leading to the south entrance of Dura.
- (ix) At 12:35 on November 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading to Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron and the entrance of Beit Anoun.
- (x) On November 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Hebron near by pass road (35) near Halhoul Bridge.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Dura.
- (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained 6 residents then withdrew at 05:30.
- (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta and detained two residents.
- (iv) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im and detained three residents.
- (v) At dawn on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Aroub camp and detained two residents.
- (vi) At dawn on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp and detained a resident.
- (vii) At dawn on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya and detained a resident.
- (viii) At dawn on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a child.
- (ix) At dawn on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces raided Ithna and detained a resident.

- **Detention:**

- (i) On the morning of November 7th 2015, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Sa'ed Abu Ramouz (A National Security Force officer) in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces detained Samer Mahmoud Tabish (A resident of Hadib Al-Fawar) near Al-Fuwar junction.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained six residents: Alaa Isam Al-Ja'bari, Jihad Abu Irmeleh (A University student), Ziyad Jamal Abu Ziena, Sayf Abu Ziena, Amjad Salhab and Yusef Shawar in Hebron.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained two residents: Firas Khaled Al-Shamsati and Oday Nidal Shartih in Yatta.
- (v) Israeli forces detained three residents: Tamer Hisham Izzat Zidat, Osama Bassam Ozid and Yazan Harahsha in Bani Na'im.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Azziz Rushdi and Tal'at Azziz Rushdi in Al-Aroub camp,
- (vii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Fayiq Nassar in Al-Fuwar camp.
- (viii) Israeli forces detained Osama Mohammad Harb Qaysiya (A University student) in Al-Thahriya.
- (ix) Israeli forces detained the child: Ali Waleed Abu Ayash (15 years old).
- (x) Israeli forces detained Hazim Jibril Al-Jiwawi in Ithna.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area located Hebron and near Dawarat area located in Sa'ir fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including 2 children: Mohammad Bassam Yahya Ahmour (16 years old), Khaldoun Ya'coub Waheed Al-Natsheh (13 years old), Raed Taher Issam Tahboub, Haytham Ghassan Omran Bader and Mohammad Abdel-Aziz Abed Shakour Al-Natsheh as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shuhada road and Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Home Occupation:**

- (i) On the morning of November 7th 2015, Israeli forces stormed the old city of Hebron and occupied three homes owned by Manour Khaled Ahmad Jaber, Mohammad Abu Hussien and Mahmoud Taha Abu Isneineh and converted their rooftops into Military posts.
- (ii) At 12:00, stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and occupied The center for "Youth Against settlements" in the old city of Hebron, confiscated surveillance cameras and several archived document files and converted their rooftops into military posts then issued an order to close down the center within 24 hours.

- **Assault on Health Sector:** At 12:00, Israeli forces stormed a health clinic located near Abu Al-Rish checkpoint in the old city Of Hebron and assaulted several clinic employees and issued an order to close down the clinic.

- **Settler Violence:**

- (i) At 15:25, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and attacked the center for "Youth Against settlements" and several other homes during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack then withdrew at 16:55.
- (ii) At 19:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and attacked the home of Imad Abu Shamsiya.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Central Gaza and as a result injured a resident.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Deir Al-Balah village. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Al-Buriej camp Jabaliya as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result injured a resident and left another suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing closed.
