JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to Jerusalem City and to prevent civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, except those holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem pursuant to military order No. 09/02S, and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Raids: At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Qatana and arrested one child under the pretext of stone throwing. Arrests: The child arrested in the village of Qatana is called Ibrahim Mousa Hoshhiyeh, 14. Settler Violence: At 19:35, a groupd of settlers entered into Palestinian land in the village of Mikhmas and set olive trees on fire damaging 15 olive trees. Wall Construction: Wall construction has resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim. 			
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying Checkpoints; (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of 'Uyun Al-Haramiyyeh (on Ramallah-Nablus Road) and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 12:55, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of the town of Turmus'ayya and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 20:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Shuqba and fired sound bombs during patrol. Settler Violence: At 04:00 on 08 November 2011, a group of settlers broke into the town of Turmus'ayya and set a commercial store owned by a civilian called

	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al- Gharbi and Rantis villages.
	• <u>Closure of Main Roads</u> : The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
	• Raids: (i) At 19:40, the Israeli army raided the villages of Al-Jalama and Arrana, fired flash grenades during training and retreated at 21:30. (ii) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin and its refugee
JENIN	camp and clashed with civilians until 03:40. (ii) At the dawn of 09 November 2011, the Israeli army raided the town of Qabatia and arrested 2 civilians including a university student. • Arrets: The 2 civilians arrested in the town of Qabatia are: a) Anas Ata Kamil.
	 b) Ahmad Hisham Kamil. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	• Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
	• Raids: At 16:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Tayaseer.
	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.

	• Flying Checkpoints: At 16:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of the village of Kafr 'Aboush and searched civilians and vehicles.
	• Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
	 Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route has resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
	Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.
QALQILYA	(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i> , the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
	 Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 15:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of the village of Jeet and searched civilians and vehicles.

- (ii) At 17:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Hijjeh and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the entrance of the town of 'Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 21:40, the Israeli army set up checkpoint on the entrance of the city of Qalqilya and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 21:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the entrance of the village of Jinasaphot and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 18:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Baqa Al-Hatab and patrolled it until 24:00. The road occurred again at 23:30.
- (ii) At 23:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Kafr Qaddoum.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to restrict times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:

(i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood.

- (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- (iii) At 10:05, the Israeli army intensified restrictions on Shavi Shomron checkpoint and impeded civilian access. The Israeli army detained a civilian called Suhaib Al-Sha'er but released him later. A second time the Israeli army intensified restrictions at 18:10 and impeded traffic.
- (iv) At 13:40, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded traffic.

• Flying checkpoints:

(i) At 10:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of the

	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues
	to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.

- (ii) At 17:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Nabi Mousa area (Hebron-Bethlehem Road) and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the entrance of the area of Al-Farsh Al-Hawa north of eh city if Hebron and searched civilians and vehicles.

Raids:

- (i) At 16:00 the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Yatta.
- (ii) At 19:50, the Israeli army raided the village f Khirbet Salama and searched 1 civilian home.
- (iii) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Himsa.
- (iv) At 00:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Al-Majd.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 02:30, a group of settlers entered into the area of Al-Thaqhra in the town of Beit 'Ummar and set the civilian vehicles on fire.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Dhahiriya town.

GAZA STRIP

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 10 April 2011. The Israeli breached the ceasefire and fired missiles on Northern Gaza and Khan Younis. Armed Palestinian breached ceasefire and fired projectiles in the Green Line.
