WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 09:40, the Israeli military intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located on the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Attack:

- (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they stormed several merchant allegedly looking for fireworks and detained three residents.
- (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for throwing of a firebomb towards an Israeli settler vehicle.
- (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
- (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Detention:

- (i) On November 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Shami after storming his home in Al-Tur neighbourhood.
- (ii) On November 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Shalabi in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii) At dawn on November 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained 10 resindets including a child: Nur Abu Zanid (17 years old), Ahmad Abu Gharbiya,

- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou'.
- (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Harsa area located in east Beit Sahur until 22:05.
- Raid: At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr and clashed with several school children.

• Attack:

- (i) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and occupied the home of Doud Al-Amour and converted its roof top into a military post.
- (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> On the evening of November 9th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Aqbat Hassna area located North West of Al-Khadr, served orders for the demolition of two homes owned by Mohammad Shuli and Samih Al-Shuli for allegedly being built without a licence.
- **<u>Destruction of Property:</u>** At 16:00 on November 7th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Husan village and served orders for the demolition of two merchant shops owned by Foad Hamarah and Mohammad Hamarah for allegedly being built without a licence.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa'

- towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate.
- (vii)At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ramadin village until 09:40.
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 15:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew at 02:05.
- (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched four homes and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Shihadeh in Hebron
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Omar Baaraghith in Beit Ummar.

Attack:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli Naval Vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah, injured 2 fisherman and destroyed two fishing boats.

NORTHERN GAZA	Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance. Attack: At dawn on November 10th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Shate' area in Rafah and as a result injured 2 unidentified fishermen and destroyed 2 fishing boats.
