#### **WEST BANK**

#### Closure:

- (i) On November 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.
- (iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) On November 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces installed Metal Detectors at Beit Iksa village checkpoint to search residents.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At dawn on November 9<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained a resident after storming his home.
- (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Anata and detained a resident after storming his home.
- (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Sawahra village and detained a resident.
- (iv) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 06:10.

### • <u>Temporary Detention:</u>

(i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint temporarily detained 2 children: Aya Ibrahim Abu Rabah (12 years old) and Susan Mohammad Abdallah Taha (13 years old) then released them at 22:20.

- (i) At dawn on November 9th 2015, Israeli forces detained 3 residents including a child: Kamal Al-Umam (14 years old), Hatem Al-Sakani and Ali Ma'touq in Al-Thouri neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram checkpoint detained Anis Yazid Daghlas (A resident of Burga village in Nablus).
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Adnan Obied in Al-Eisawiya village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Basil Mustafa Ibrahim Sabah in Anata.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Samiya Musa Mashahrah in Al-Suwahra village.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

#### Wall Gates:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu (i) Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the iunction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages
- (ii) On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) On November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Silwad and Ein Yabroud village.

#### Raid:

- (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Ein Yabroud village, stormed a Furniture shop then withdrew at 16:50.
- (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Jifna village, stormed a merchant shop and confiscated surveillance camera footage from the shop then withdrew at
- (iii) At 17:15, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed a building and set up a checkpoint and searched vehicles and inspected reisndets identification cards until 17:35.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Nabi Saleh village opened fire towards a vehicle owned by Mohammad Al-Khatib and as a result damaged
- (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at "Pesagout" settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
- (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound ) for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near Budrous village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 19:05, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Shuqba village opened fire towards a resident and as a result injured him then proceeded to detain him.

#### • Temporary Detention:

- (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Hablah village temporarily detained three residents: Mohammad Shihab, Aref Shihab and Ibrahim Sayis (All residents of Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem) then released them later.
- (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned along the main road in Al-Nabi Eliyas village temporarily detained a Palestine Television journalist then released them at 12:50.
- Attack: At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left 2 residents and left 29 other suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

#### **Wall Gates:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Oarvut.
- (iii) At 22:00 on October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds.

#### Checkpoints:

- (i) At 19:25, The Israeli Military intensified its restrictions at the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:00.
- (ii) 18:45, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:35.

- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 1305.
- (ii) At 13:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Khirbeit Al-Deir village located near Taqou' then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 15:00.
- (iii) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards.
- (iv) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 19:45.
- (v) At 19:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr then searched vehicles and inspected resident's identification cards until 22:00.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village and stormed a home.
- (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya, detained a child and summoned 3 children: Suhayedb Ibrahim Hassasneh (15 years old), Ali Mohammad Shantiya (17 years old) and Daoud Jamal Shantiya (17 years old) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, Al-Ayda and Al-Aza camp in Bethlehem and summoned 2 residents: Sadam Mustafa Dar Al-Haj (A resident of Al-Ayda camp) and Jihad Mohammad Abu Sha'ira (A resident of Al-Aza camp) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:40.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mujahid Na'im Abu Sarhan (17 years old) on Al-Obidiya.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 12:35, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Khadr fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Mina village located in South Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Ahmad Ibrahim Suliman Al-Amour (17 years old) leaving him hospitalised.

#### **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
