#### **WEST BANK**

#### • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque.
- (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram.
- (iii) On 28 May 2010, the Israeli army closed the eastern entrance to the village of Beit Iksa, which leads to the city of Jerusalem, by an iron gate, and told civilians to pass through Qalandiya checkpoint to Jerusalem city.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem.

#### • Raids:

- (i) In the morning of 10 November 2010, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Isawiya where confrontations took place with civilians. Again at dawn on 11 November 2010, the Israeli army raided the village, searched a number of houses and arrested 5 civilians.
- (ii) At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Bir Nabala and arrested 6 civilians.

## • <u>Arrests</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army arrested in the village of Al Isawiya 5 unknown civilians.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested in the town of Bir Nabala the civilians: Sameer Bajes Abdallah; Sameer Ahmad Dirbashi; Samer Yaser Abdallah; Abdulkareem Faisal Zeidan; Eili Naser Hajja; and Ahmad Nasr Hajja.

## • Wall Gates:


- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians

	holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.  • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area

TULKAREM	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoint: At 10:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Kafriyat Road, which connects the districts of Tulkarm and Qalqiliya, and searched civilians and vehicles until 11:20.</li> <li>Raids: <ol> <li>At 15:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Ramin.</li> <li>At 22:05, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir Al Ghussun, searched a house, detained the civilian Thabet Abdulfattah Al Qab and released him after conducting field interrogation with him and withdrew at 23:00.</li> <li>Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.</li> </ol> </li></ul>
QALQILYA	<ul> <li>Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoints: <ol> <li>At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the entrance to the village of Hajja and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:00.</li> <li>At 18:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of 'Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>At 20:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Kafr Laqif.</li> <li>At 03:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Jit and searched civilians and vehicles until 04:30.</li> <li>Raids: At 08:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqiliya, searched a house, severely beat the civilian Naser Al Astal and arrested a civilian. Again at 02:40, the Israeli army raided the city, searched 3 houses and arrested another civilian.</li> <li>Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the city of Qalqiliya the following civilians: 'Adel Sulaiman Abu Dhail and Mahdi Adnan Muhammad Dawoud.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

## **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma (i) Wall gate and search civilians, including students, with a detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to (ii) the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha and prevent the access of its inhabitants. The Israeli army only allows the passage of students to their schools outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through gate # 109. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues on land belonging to the village of Kafr Laqif, north of the settlement of Karni Shomron, on land belonging to the village of Immatin, northeast of the settlement of 'Amano'el, and east of the town of Kafr Thulth near the settlement of Ma'aleh Shomron. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit (i) Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town (ii) of Qabalan; the southern entrances to the villages of Duma and Qaryut; and the western entrance to An Nagura village opposite Shavei Shomron settlement. **Checkpoints:** (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from **NABLUS** 07:00 until 02:00. Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until (ii) 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00. At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Huwwara (iii) checkpoint and impeded civilian access. **Flying Checkpoints:** (i) At 10:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the town of Qabalan and searched civilians and vehicles. At 21:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area (ii) between the town of 'Agraba and the village of Osarin and searched civilians and vehicles until 22:00. At 23:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction (iii) leading to the village of Beit Wazan and searched civilians and vehicles. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern (i) SALFIT entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Brugin.



- An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) As of 15 September 2007, the Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access, pursuant to military order # 07/02, to 22 *dunum* area confiscated according to military order # 07/31 to establish a crossing point in the area of Al Mazmuriya between the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.
- Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town of Taqu'a and the village of Khirbet Al Baq'a.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 20:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Za'tara until 20:20.
- (ii) At 00:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Walaja and searched a number of houses.
- (iii) At 01:15, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Jala and arrested a civilian.
- (iv) At 04:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar, set up a flying checkpoint and patrolled the area.

## • Arrests:

- (i) At 09:55, the Israeli army arrested at Al Container checkpoint 2 unknown civilians after confiscating their vehicle.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested in the city of Beit Jala the civilian Muhammad Taha Mustafa Abu Jamal.
- <u>Detentions</u>: At 10:45, the Israeli army detained at Al Container checkpoint 6 Palestinian National Security officers while traveling from Bethlehem district to Jericho city. The Israeli army released them following DCO intervention.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 11:00, a sit in demonstration by families of political prisoners took place in front of the Nativity yard in the city of Bethlehem in solidarity with their children in Israeli prisons and demanding their release.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.

# **HEBRON**

The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruit and

- vegetable market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # 09/06 closing the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta, evacuating those inside it and preventing civilians from accessing it. This is the land seized for military purposes for the construction of the Wall.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.

## • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass leading to the town of Halhul. Again at 16:40 and at 21:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 18:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Fawwar junction and searched civilians and vehicles.


#### • Raids:

- (i) At 11:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron. Again at 14:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area.
- (ii) At 14:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Adh Dhahiriya and patrolled the area.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# ALL DISTRICTS

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period.



 Armed Palestinian groups breached the ceasefire by detonating an explosive device near an Israeli army patrol driving near the Green Line.

## Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for **NORTHERN** the passage of critically ill civilians, foreign journalists, the staff of international humanitarian organizations, traders, businessmen and civilians GAZA travelling through Al Karama Crossing who have prior coordination. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. (i) **GAZA** Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since (ii) 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision. **CENTRAL** Activities not reported. **GAZA** Raid: At 12:00, the Israeli army, including a number of armored

# KHAN YOUNIS

- Raid: At 12:00, the Israeli army, including a number of armored vehicles and bulldozers covered by reconnaissance aircrafts, raided Palestinian territory east of Al Qarara town and opened fire intensively towards civilian agricultural land and houses while leveling an area of land.
- <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: At 08:15, armed Palestinian individuals detonated an explosive device near an Israeli army patrol driving near the border fence. Consequently, the Israeli army opened fire intensively towards Palestinian territory east of Al Qarara town.

## • Closure of Crossing Points:

- (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.
- (ii) Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is open for the departure of the 8<sup>th</sup> batch of pilgrims.
- (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.

#### **RAFAH**

- (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entry of food, humanitarian assistance, a quantity of diesel for the electricity plant and cooking gas.
- Raid: In the morning of 10 November 2010, the Israeli army, including a number of armored vehicles and bulldozers covered by helicopter gunships and reconnaissance aircrafts, raided Palestinian territory east of An Nahda neighborhood, east of Rafah city, and opened fire intensively towards civilian agricultural land and houses while leveling an area of land.
